Supported Countries	Supported countries for the product's operations. We first list all African countries, followed by English/French as major lingua franca in the African continent.

Supported Currencies	Supported currencies for the product's operations. We first list all African currencies, followed by USD/GBP as major informal or formal mediums of currencies in the African continent. Other currencies that the product support may be excluded.
Supported Languages	Supported languages for the product's operations. We first list English/French followed by major African languages that the product is currently communicated or translated to.
Supported Blockchains	Non-exhaustive list of major blockchains for the product's operations.
Supported Tokens	Non-exhaustive list of major tokens for the product's operations including exchange, trading, earning opportunities This includes the native token of the product as well as associated major tokens. .
