**Topic: The Preacher Likes Ice Cream** 

Scripture: Mark 3: 13-19

**Focus Verse:** "These are the twelve he chose: Simon (who he named Peter), James and John (the sons of Zebedee, but Jesus nicknamed them "Sons of Thunder"), Andrew, Philip, Bartholomew, Matthew, Thomas, James (son of Alphaeus), Thaddaeus, Simon (the zealot), Judas Iscariot (who later betrayed him)."
