Registration:

Summer School Online Registration Opens:

- Tuesday, April 5th at 6:00 PM Middle and High School classes
- Tuesday, April 12th at 6:00 PM Intermediate School classes
- Tuesday, April 19th at 6:00 PM All Elementary School classes, swimming and Camp Invention

A staggered registration schedule will speed up the registration process for all. It should also help our families with students at multiple age levels to be able to focus on each individual student.

Adding/dropping classes: Families will be able to add or drop classes on their own by logging into their Summer School registration account and making the changes themselves. If you wish to replace a class, you need to drop the old class first prior to registering for the new class. Adding classes is subject to availability. **The deadline for registration is May 13th at noon. No late registrations will be accepted.**

Elementary Courses: The title of all the elementary courses include the school where the class is located. Each class will have one of the following abbreviations for the elementary school building the class is located at:

AES: Arboretum Elementary School

HES: Heritage Elementary School

PES: Prairie Elementary School

When registering online, please be careful that you are selecting the class at the location you wish to have your student attend.

Transportation:

Eligibility for Summer School Transportation

Only students who reside in a bus zone area will be eligible for Summer School busing. Those students will be bused to/from home and school at the beginning and end of the Summer School day. There is no busing provided during the middle of the Summer School day, for swimming lessons

or strength and conditioning. There is no busing provided for music lessons that end outside of normal Summer School hours.

You will not need to register your student for transportation. If your student meets the eligibility requirements for Summer School transportation, they will automatically be enrolled. Letters with details on their bus route location and times will be mailed by June 10, 2022.

If you are the parent of an elementary student and you are planning on your student riding the bus only one way or not riding at all, please complete the Summer School Transportation Opt Out Form. This form can be found on the district website under Families->Transportation. Students will be placed on their bus on a daily basis unless this form is completed. Opt out forms filled out for the school year do not apply to summer school. If you want to occasionally pick up your student, you can arrange for that by calling the Summer School attendance line prior to 10:00 AM on the day you will be picking them up.

2022 Summer School Alternate Pick-up/Drop off Transportation Requirements

If your child will be transported to/from any location other than their home address, completion of the online alternate transportation form is required. Alternate transportation forms filled out for the school year do not apply to summer school. **May 13, 2022 at noon– Alternate Transportation Registration closes.** You will not be able to request alternate transportation after this date.
