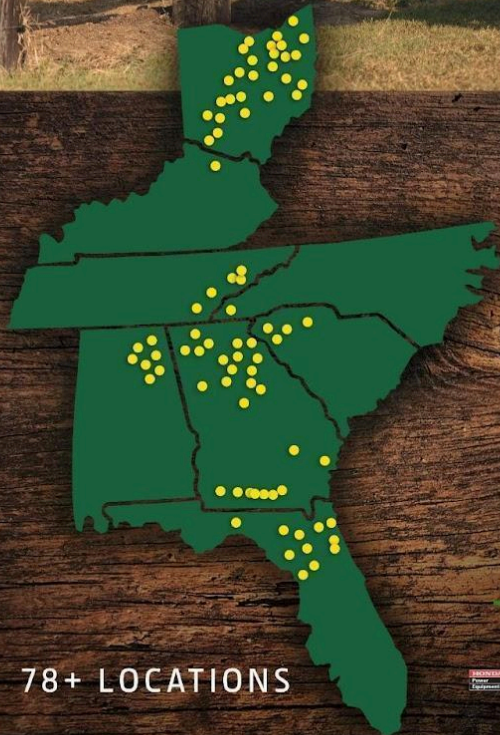

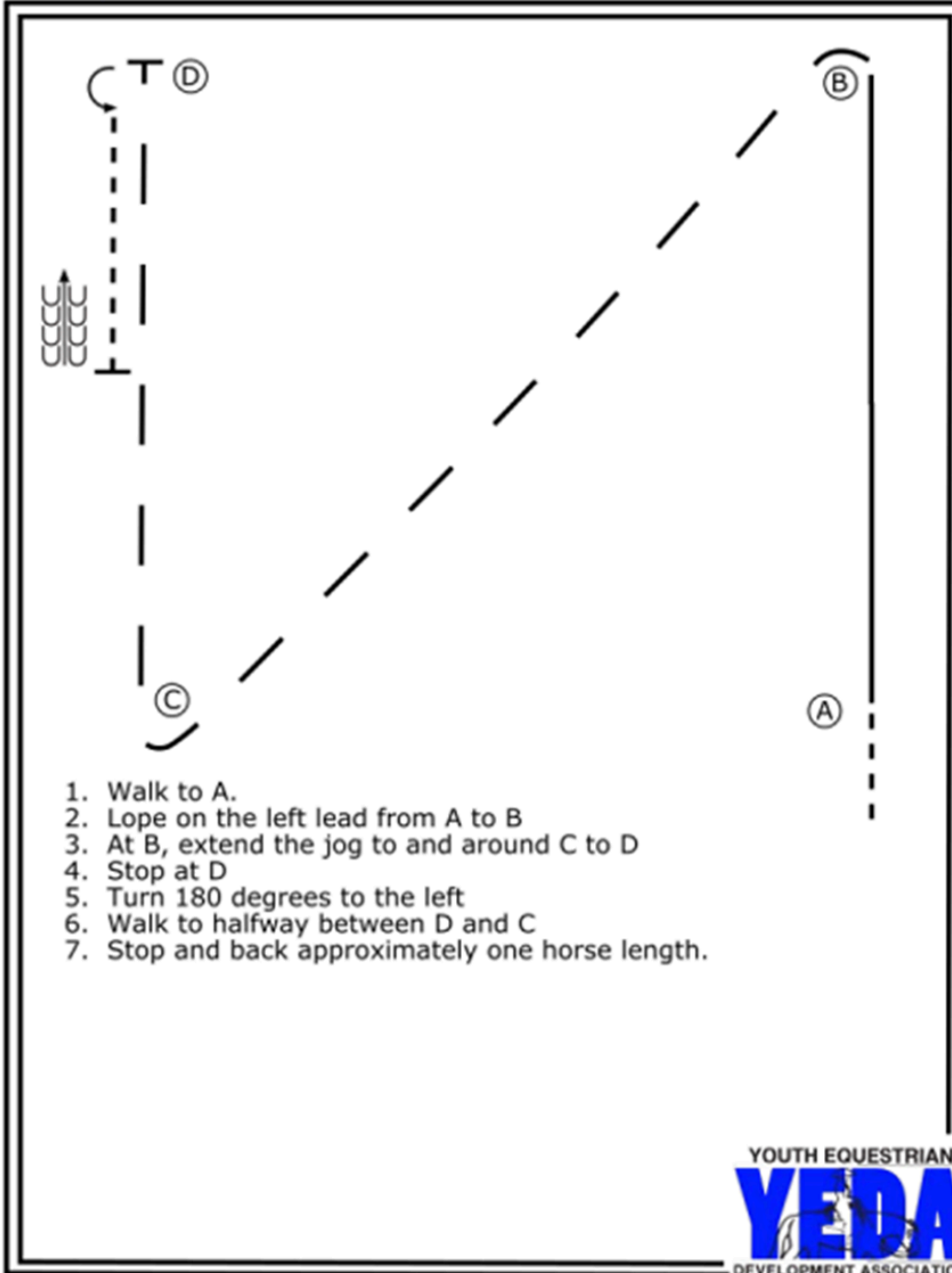

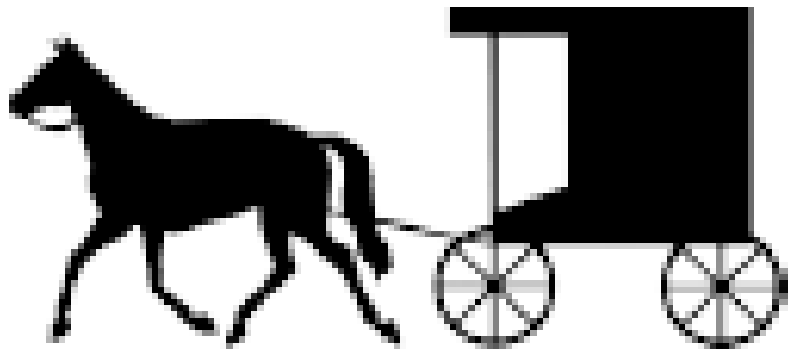
Diamond Pattern 6

1. **Doug (DMB)** – A bit un-cadenced at the jog, but will do it all day long. Ride leg to hand, will collect up and lope super slow. He will canter (smoothly) if you let him. Set up for leads by pointing nose to the wall and hip towards the center. Does not have a flying lead change. Two hand only. No spurs.
2. **Prada (DMB)** – Straight forward draw, one vice is that she will quit easy (she won't get locked up or stuck, super easy to motivate back into gait) so ride every stride. Take time and set up the right lead. Does not have a flying lead change. 1 or 2 handed. No spurs.
3. **Chase (EQD)** - Sorrel/White APHA gelding. Guide with legs for better steering. Bump with legs for jog transitions. Set up for leads and support with lots of leg to keep the lope. Can be lazy. Two hand option. 2 hands better for patterns. Push forward into pivots or he'll pivot on the forehand. Squeeze and lift hand for back up. Division appropriate spurs, crop option.
4. **Lucy (EQD)** – Good Draw, medium contact, 1 hand, Division appropriate spurs, must set up for right lead
5. **Riley (EQD)** – Sorrel QH gelding. Light rein contact. Soft legs. If he wants to go slow, let him. Don't be pushy. - Soft cues for leads and pattern work. Soft legs for jog transition, soft consistent push for lope. Division appropriate spurs, but don't overuse them.
6. **Melody (EQD)** - Red Dun QH mare. Needs ridden with soft contact but not a lot of bit pressure. Support with leg for lope. Spurs needed for lope. Division appropriate spur and crop ok for walk trot.
7. **Elvis (Hancock)** - Good straight forward draw. Can be lazy, use crop in walk/jog and ball spurs for the upper levels.
8. **Gretel (Hancock)** - Ranch horse. Medium contact. She has a bumpier trot but is still soft. Set up for left lead. Use clear but strong signals for right to left lead change. Ball spurs ok.
9. b - Light to medium contact. Use legs to keep true gaits. Set up for right lead. Ball Spur, Crop option for walk/trot
10. **Janice (Hancock)** - Bay Mustang Mare. Good draw. Takes her leads well as long as you set her up correctly. Must set her up and use effective leg for lead change. Listens to voice commands for downward and upward transitions. Do not trap her in the face, use light contact and give and take. She will listen very well to leg and seat for turning. Division appropriate spurs and crop option for walk trot. One Handed.
11. **Jersey (Hancock)** - Ranch Type. Ball spur if you are soft with it she is fine with no spur. Ride with contact but keep feel, Don't trap. She will anticipate and respond quickly so ask lightly. Fast spins and pivots.
12. **Jerry (Hancock)** - Ranch Type. Great Draw. Division Appropriate spurs and he is sometimes lazy. Use very light contact, longer reins. Easy to ride. Height Weight
13. **Maycie (Hancock)** - Good, straight forward draw. Medium contact with a steady hand. Don't trap her up. Keep a deep, heavy seat and leg contact to slow her down. Takes her leads well, keep her forward into the right pivot. Ball Spur option for loping classes only. Use leg first and only light spur when needed.
14. **Slick (Hancock)** - Straightforward draw. Light to medium contact. Can be lazy. Use your legs to keep a rhythm and to keep him forward. Crop option for walk/trot. Ball spur.
15. **Eclipse (Haven's Hope & IU)** – Light rein contact. ½ inch slack. Click to trot, kiss to canter, with leg to go forward. Sit back, say "whoa", apply rein pressure to stop. Light rein pressure to back. Two handed. No spurs. (To be used for both IHSA & YEDA)

16. **JLo (Haven's Hope)** - Pleasure type all around/ranch. One handed. Division appropriate spurs.
17. **Sugar (Havens Hope)** - One or two handed. No spurs.
18. **Sunny (Haven's Hope)** - Ranch type (more forward than pleasure). One or two handed. Division appropriate spurs but not needed.
19. **Waylon (Indiana Elite)** – Western pleasure all around. Spur trained. 1 or 2 handed.
20. **Ollie (Indiana Elite)** – Reining/Ranch trained. 1 or 2 handed. Division appropriate spurs.
21. **Pickles (Miami)** – Very “feely” horse – will require steady contact leg to hand and leg should protect her belly throughout. You must plan ahead and organize. She will anticipate lope departures if not connected prior. Has a bouncy trot for pattern classes. Keep her connected and set the rhythm. Division appropriate spurs.
22. **Jellybean (Miami)** - Very comfortable, good and honest ride. Rides like a ranch type horse, so keep in front of leg and don't try to overbridle. He can go to contact and will bridle up, but don't make his neck too short. Two hand option for patterns only.
23. **Mac (St Mary of the Woods)** - Height/Weight horse. 15.1H Bay Quarter Horse. Old reiner. Safe and good boy for all classes. Division appropriate spurs.
24. **Eric (SL)** – Ranch/reining type. Will go around better without being held in frame. Two hand option. Division appropriate spurs.
25. **Gator (SL)** – Can be lazy, but will trot off. Don't over bridle. No crop. Division appropriate spurs.
26. **Misty (SL)** – Reining type with a spur stop. Hug with your legs and hold her with a light frame. Two hand option. Division appropriate spurs.
27. **Peanut (SL)** – Sweet lazy mare. Easier to keep going than to get going. Ask early at the cone for the jog. Great stop. Legs off and slight rein pressure to back. Crop option, 2 handed. Division appropriate spurs.
28. **Chex (Timmermann's)** – Sorrel show horse with all the buttons. To lope pull outside heel in and hold and kiss. Keep your outside leg on. Pivots with more leg and less hands. Do not kick, squeeze to extend jog. Ball spurs only.
29. **Maiposa (Timmermann's)** – Paint show horse with all the buttons. Keep your outside leg on for lope. Pivots with more leg and less hands. Ball spurs only.
30. **Chrome (Timmermann's)** – Bay/white paint ranchy mare, can get a little hyper at the gate but will calm right down once in the arena. Can be lazy to lope off, hold outside heel in and kiss for the best lope off. Has spin and flying lead change. If you let your legs bounce she will get really fast. Keep your spur off once you are going. Ball Spurs.
31. **Cabana (Timmermann's)** - All around show horse. Very responsive to legs. Keep your outside leg on while loping for a better collection. Keep him slow. If you let him get going fast he will take advantage and get speedy. For back, squeeze with feet while pulling reins. For pivot, light rein contact, while using your leg (more feet, less hands). No spurs.
32. **Fiddler (Timmermann's)** - Ranchy big gelding. Very responsive, keep your legs off. Need soft and slow for hands and legs. He will jog and lope slow, but you need to gently remind him. Do not hang on his face, it makes him nervous. More feet than hands to pivot. Feet off to back. No spurs.
33. **Louie (Timmermann's)** - Reiner/Ranch horse. Been working lessons with all raiders. Set up for left lead. Will lope fast unless you hold him collected. Great spins, easy lead changes and decent slite. Honest horse. 2 hand option. No crop and no spurs.

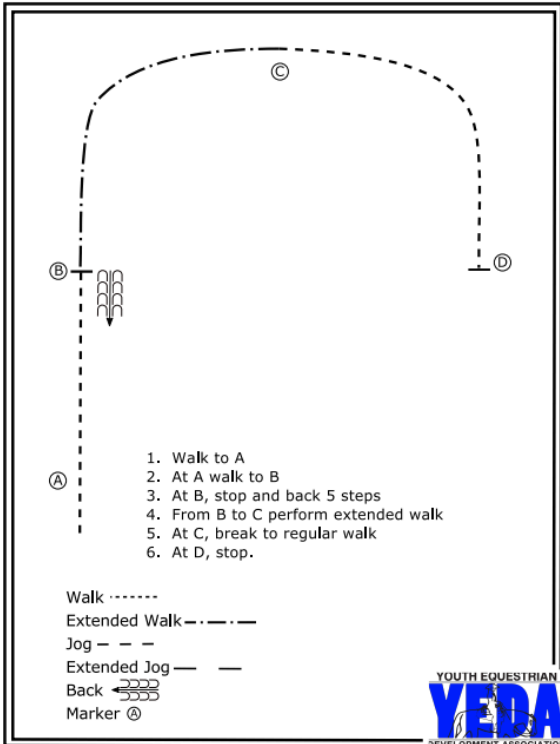

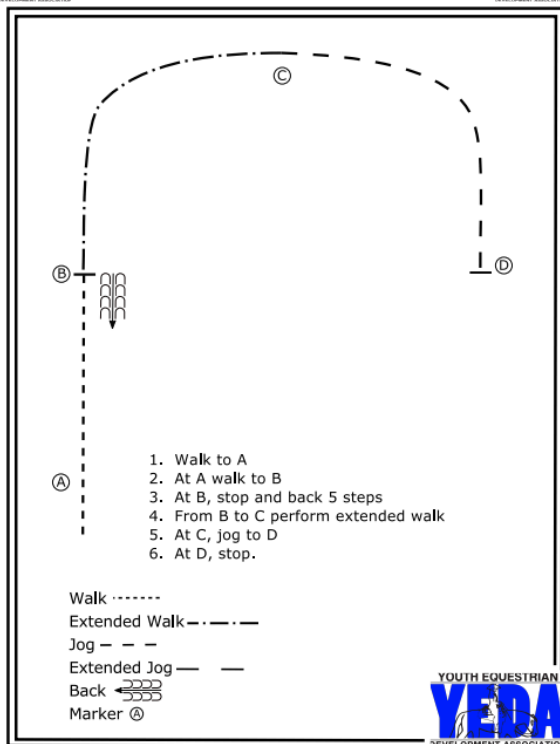

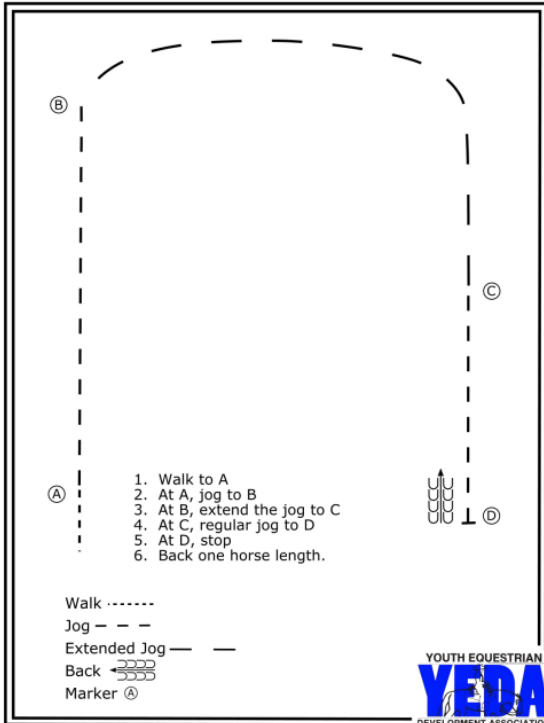
Amber EWD Walk Pattern 3,4



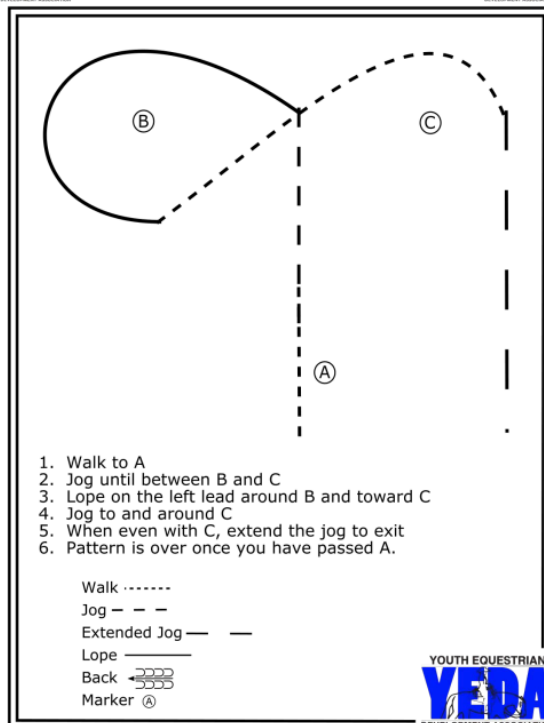

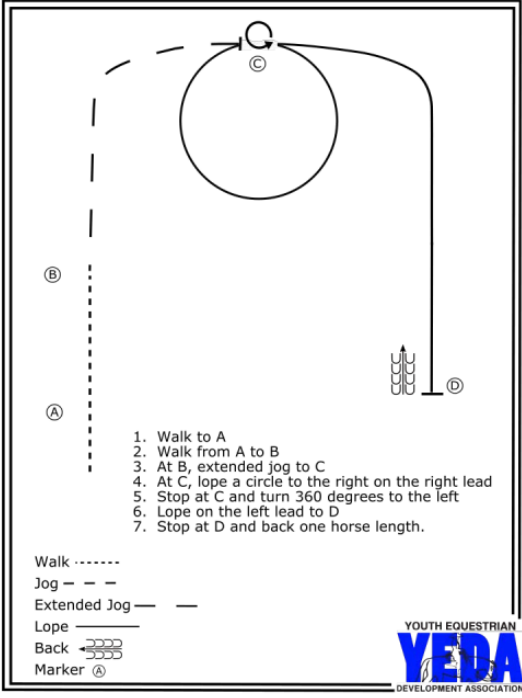
Pearl/Opal Pattern 4



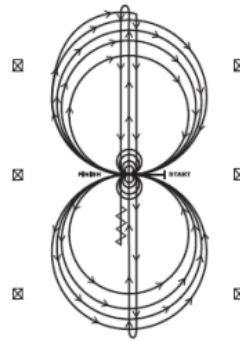
Ruby Pattern 4

NRHA Pattern 4



Horses may walk or jog to the center of the arena. Horses must walk or stop prior to starting pattern. Beginning at the center of the arena facing the left wall or fence.

1. Beginning on the right lead, complete three circles to the right: the first two large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Stop at the center of the arena. Hesitate.
2. Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.
3. Beginning on the left lead, complete three circles to the left: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Stop at the center of the arena. Hesitate.
4. Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate.
5. Beginning on the right lead, run a large fast circle to the right, change leads at the center of the arena, run large fast circle to the left, and change leads at the center of the arena, (Figure 8)
6. Continue around previous circle to the right. At the top of the circle, run down the middle to the far end of the arena past the end marker and do a right rollback—no hesitation.
7. Run up the middle to the opposite end of the arena past the end marker and do a left rollback—no hesitation.
8. Run past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Backup to the center of the arena or at least ten feet (three meters). Hesitate to demonstrate completion of the pattern.

Horse Descriptions

1. **Doug (DMB)** – A bit un-cadenced at the jog, but will do it all day long. Ride leg to hand, will collect up and lope super slow. He will canter (smoothly) if you let him. Set up for leads by pointing nose to the wall and hip towards the center. Does not have a flying lead change. Two hand only. No spurs.
2. **Prada (DMB)** – Straight forward draw, one vice is that she will quit easy (she won't get locked up or stuck, super easy to motivate back into gait) so ride every stride. Take time and set up the right lead. Does not have a flying lead change. 1 or 2 handed. No spurs.
3. **Chase (EQD)** - Sorrel/White APHA gelding. Guide with legs for better steering. Bump with legs for jog transitions. Set up for leads and support with lots of leg to keep the lope. Can be lazy. Two hand option. 2 hands better for patterns. Push forward into pivots or he'll pivot on the forehand. Squeeze and lift hand for back up. Division appropriate spurs, crop option.
4. **Lucy (EQD)** – Good Draw, medium contact, 1 hand, Division appropriate spurs, must set up for right lead
5. **Riley (EQD)** – Sorrel QH gelding. Light rein contact. Soft legs. If he wants to go slow, let him. Don't be pushy. - Soft cues for leads and pattern work. Soft legs for jog transition, soft consistent push for lope. Division appropriate spurs, but don't overuse them.
6. **Melody (EQD)** - Red Dun QH mare. Needs ridden with soft contact but not a lot of bit pressure. Support with leg for lope. Spurs needed for lope. Division appropriate spur and crop ok for walk trot.
7. **Elvis (Hancock)** - Good straight forward draw. Can be lazy, use crop in walk/jog and ball spurs for the upper levels.
8. **Gretel (Hancock)** - Ranch horse. Medium contact. She has a bumpier trot but is still soft. Set up for left lead. Use clear but strong signals for right to left lead change. Ball spurs ok.
9. **Ike (Hancock)** - Light to medium contact. Use legs to keep true gaits. Set up for right lead. Ball Spur, Crop option for walk/trot
10. **Janice (Hancock)** - Bay Mustang Mare. Good draw. Takes her leads well as long as you set her up correctly. Must set her up and use effective leg for lead change. Listens to voice commands for downward and upward transitions. Do not trap her in the face, use light contact and give and take. She will listen very well to leg and seat for turning. Division appropriate spurs and crop option for walk trot. One Handed.
11. **Jersey (Hancock)** - Ranch Type. Ball spur if you are soft with it she is fine with no spur. Ride with contact but keep feel, Don't trap. She will anticipate and respond quickly so ask lightly. Fast spins and pivots.
12. **Jerry (Hancock)** - Ranch Type. Great Draw. Division Appropriate spurs and he is sometimes lazy. Use very light contact, longer reins. Easy to ride. Height Weight

13. **Maycie (Hancock)** - Good, straight forward draw. Medium contact with a steady hand. Don't trap her up. Keep a deep, heavy seat and leg contact to slow her down. Takes her leads well, keep her forward into the right pivot. Ball Spur option for loping classes only. Use leg first and only light spur when needed.
14. **Slick (Hancock)** - Straightforward draw. Light to medium contact. Can be lazy. Use your legs to keep a rhythm and to keep him forward. Crop option for walk/trot. Ball spur.
15. **Eclipse (Haven's Hope & IU)** – Light rein contact. ½ inch slack. Click to trot, kiss to canter, with leg to go forward. Sit back, say “whoa”, apply rein pressure to stop. Light rein pressure to back. Two handed. No spurs. (To be used for both IHSA & YEDA)
16. **JLo (Haven's Hope)** - Pleasure type all around/ranch. One handed. Division appropriate spurs.
17. **Sugar (Havens Hope)** - One or two handed. No spurs.
18. **Sunny (Haven's Hope)** - Ranch type (more forward than pleasure). One or two handed. Division appropriate spurs but not needed.
19. **Waylon (Indiana Elite)** – Western pleasure all around. Spur trained. 1 or 2 handed.
20. **Ollie (Indiana Elite)** – Reining/Ranch trained. 1 or 2 handed. Division appropriate spurs.
21. **Pickles (Miami)** – Very “feely” horse – will require steady contact leg to hand and leg should protect her belly throughout. You must plan ahead and organize. She will anticipate lope departures if not connected prior. Has a bouncy trot for pattern classes. Keep her connected and set the rhythm. Division appropriate spurs.
22. **Jellybean (Miami)** - Very comfortable, good and honest ride. Rides like a ranch type horse, so keep in front of leg and don't try to overbridle. He can go to contact and will bridle up, but don't make his neck too short. Two hand option for patterns only.
23. **Mac (St Mary of the Woods)** - Height/Weight horse. 15.1H Bay Quarter Horse. Old reiner. Safe and good boy for all classes. Division appropriate spurs.
24. **Eric (SL)** – Ranch/reining type. Will go around better without being held in frame. Two hand option. Division appropriate spurs.
25. **Gator (SL)** – Can be lazy, but will trot off. Don't over bridle. No crop. Division appropriate spurs.
26. **Misty (SL)** – Reining type with a spur stop. Hug with your legs and hold her with a light frame. Two hand option. Division appropriate spurs.
27. **Peanut (SL)** – Sweet lazy mare. Easier to keep going than to get going. Ask early at the cone for the jog. Great stop. Legs off and slight rein pressure to back. Crop option, 2 handed. Division appropriate spurs.

28. **Chex** (Timmermann's) – Sorrel show horse with all the buttons. To lope pull outside heel in and hold and kiss. Keep your outside leg on. Pivots with more leg and less hands. Do not kick, squeeze to extend jog. Ball spurs only.
29. **Maiposa** (Timmermann's) – Paint show horse with all the buttons. Keep your outside leg on for lope. Pivots with more leg and less hands. Ball spurs only.
30. **Chrome** (Timmermann's) – Bay/white paint ranchy mare, can get a little hyper at the gate but will calm right down once in the arena. Can be lazy to lope off, hold outside heel in and kiss for the best lope off. Has spin and flying lead change. If you let your legs bounce she will get really fast. Keep your spur off once you are going. Ball Spurs.
31. **Cabana** (Timmermann's) - All around show horse. Very responsive to legs. Keep your outside leg on while loping for a better collection. Keep him slow. If you let him get going fast he will take advantage and get speedy. For back, squeeze with feet while pulling reins. For pivot, light rein contact, while using your leg (more feet, less hands). No spurs.
32. **Fiddler** (Timmermann's) - Ranchy big gelding. Very responsive, keep your legs off. Need soft and slow for hands and legs. He will jog and lope slow, but you need to gently remind him. Do not hang on his face, it makes him nervous. More feet than hands to pivot. Feet off to back. No spurs.
33. **Louie** (Timmermann's) - Reiner/Ranch horse. Been working lessons with all raiders. Set up for left lead. Will lope fast unless you hold him collected. Great spins, easy lead changes and decent slite. Honest horse. 2 hand option. No crop and no spurs.
34. **Kermit** (St Mary of the Woods) Bay QH Gelding, Old reiner. Set up for left lead. Step forward to pivot. Great draw Set up STRAIGHT for a lead change, Division Appropriate Spurs. 1 Hand
35. **Solomon** (St Mary of the Woods) - Bay QH Gelding, Division Appropriate Spurs. 1 Hand, Old reiner. Very straightforward. Bouncy trot. Hum to slow

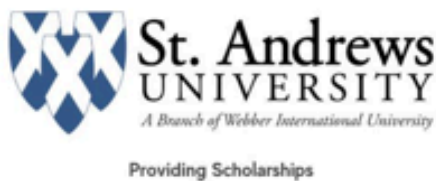
