- ___ Noticing new and interesting words, and practice using them when having book discussions
- ___ Figuring out the meaning of words used in Science and Social Studies related books, using pictures and definitions in the glossary
- ___ Summarizing a longer story with multiple scenes
- ___ Identifying important ideas from a text and explaining their thoughts through writing
- ___ Demonstrating understanding of character, using parts of the story to explain their thoughts and opinions
- ___ Making statements about characters by studying the choices they make, how they treat other characters, and how they react towards problems
- ___ Using personal experiences to better understand the characters and events of a story
- ___ Identifying the message (theme) of a text by thinking about what they've learned from the story or characters
- ___ Stopping to think about the text to notice what they are thinking and jot their ideas down on a post-it
- ___ Changing what they think about characters after reading more of the story
- ___ Making many different predictions and then confirming their ideas when they are correct or changing their thinking and getting rid of predictions when they no longer match the story
