

Each family with youth has been included to do the flag project once during the year. The scheduled assignments for the year are above

As has been done in the past, if for some reason you are not able to participate on your assigned day, it is YOUR responsibility to trade with another family. Please do not contact the lead family and tell them that you cannot make it. Each family is only asked to do one holiday a year.

The lead family is responsible for picking up the keys to the shed and the route maps from me, Hyrum Cannon, the day before the assigned holiday. In addition, they will be coordinating with all of the day's group about the time you will be meeting to put the flags up and take them down.

Please have the flags up by 8 AM and down before dark. Holidays that overlap with a school day may need adjusting for setting up times; it is up to the lead family to decide an appropriate time to get them up.

If you have to switch days, please let me know once you have a replacement. You can text or email me. Thanks!

As far as I know we have access to all the flags and rebar as we did last year. If we are sharing with the other ward, our rebar is the red based rebar. If for some reason you end up short on flags please let me know immediately so that we can have this fixed by the next time around. PLEASE do not set flags out unless they are attached on both ends. In addition, if you notice any flags that are in need of being replaced will you please separate those flags and leave them by my front door after picking them up and I will take care of getting the flag replaced and the old one retired.

In case of rain, we leave the flags unfurled so they can dry out and avoid molding. The lead family is in charge of ensuring the flags are stored appropriately and the storage unit locked, then return the keys and maps to me.
