

According to Section 10-20.56 of the Illinois School Code [105 ILCS 5/10-20.56], school districts may, by adopted resolution, utilize “e-learning days” in lieu of emergency days. The number of E-Learning days may not exceed the number of emergency days in the approved school calendar. The district’s E-Learning program must be verified by the regional office of education or intermediate service center for the school district prior to implementation. Please note that the current emergency E-Learning plan was approved by the Board of Education following a public hearing and vote on Monday, January 29, 2024, and was verified by the Regional Superintendent on February 5, 2024. While the next formal renewal of this plan is required prior to the 2026-27 school year, we will continue to re-evaluate the plan on an annual basis.

*Elementary Classroom Teachers**

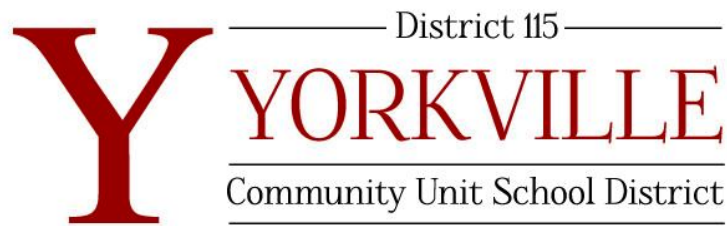
