# **INCOME INEQUALITY IN OUR WORLD**

#### WHAT is it?

<u>INCOME INEQUALITY</u> is the <u>uneven distribution of</u><u>wealth</u> (money and resources) among a population;<u>the gap</u> between the rich and the poor.





## WHERE is it happening?

Income Inequality exists within a country (ex. Northern and Southern India) OR between countries (ex. Switzerland and Democratic Republic of Congo)

#### WHY should we care?

- Because it's not fair! The gap between the rich and the poor is widening (the wealthiest 1% own 50% of the world's resources)
- Because we live in a global community (we should care about sharing the world's resources more evenly and fairly). WHY?



3. <u>Because global sustainability matters</u> - if we don't address the problem of poverty, population growth will continue. This affects us and future generations.

# How much richer are the richest 20% than the poorest 20%?



