Interview 1

Intro

- Ecosystem agent - works for Kusamarian, multiple weekly segments
- Active in Chaos DAO, Has his own consulting company finding ground new projects in the ecosystem (funding, tokenomics all expect development).
- Very involved in Polkadot ecosystem (and in web3 in general)
- Trading Experience
 - Use swap from time to time - couple of times during month
 - Big fan of Hydration

v1 Feedback

- Price ratio for swap should be other way around

Pool:

- If there are APR we should write it down
- MAX button - or percentage (useful for DED and other tokens with a lot of digits)
- Buffer for fees -if you use MAX

Dashboard:

- It's too simple, chart or something to make me stay here (reper Hydration)
- Other assets - do we need it at all?
- What is the benefit of DEX on Asset Hub? Hydra is launching soon different and easier way for custom tokens to be added. It will be very easy We will have low liquidity if we spread to HydraDX, Asset Hub
- Didn't recognize cross out from Hydra
- Cross in should be Cross out - wording is wrong.

- Implement Hydra-like notifications speed up - it will be much faster and user does not care for block finality
- DED- all chain portfolio
- Slippage: Change from word "Auto" to word "default"
- V1 needs some charts - to decide if I want swaps or not
- MAX button didn't work, I think after the arrow switch
- Pending notifications - leave it there since there is quite space for info there
- Basic / Pro version - make a **switcher**

v2 Feedback

Dashboard:

- Consider removing DED and similar meme coins from TOP Assets - put foreign assets there as they are much more important assets.
- In Talisman - top tokens are the tokens I own in descending order of balance, not alphabetic order or something like that
- Add filter option for dust tokens - everything below 5 USD or so
- It's misleading to show the balance of DOT on the top of the page - **since gas is very low, just show the token in which I am paying gas**
- Don't put pools under swap - before I start trading I check the TVL from pools so I need it on the Left navigation bar - Liquidity

Graph:

- If I want to buy some DED, I want to see it's price in USD, no one really will talk about the ratio DOT-DED. That's less important. Price of the token in USD or Euro - this price ratio tells me nothing.
- ADD: Live Trade history from this DEX what got traded - see it every minute

Swap:

- Useless countdown for not sufficient fees - make it like a button and just show some message to the user when you fall back to the next token for paying fees.

Pools:

- Fix number formatting
- My liquidity add to left navigation bar - Liquidity instead of pools
- How much I put in and how much I have now, and what is my impermanent loss - deposited 5DOT and 100 USDC - current balance 22 DOT and 120 USDC)

- How much I earned - I need to have that information / do a little graph

Create pool:

- Add pool: message for the user he is the first one
- I never did a custom pool myself

Wrap up

- V2 is much better than v1, provide a lot of additional information important to perform swaps.

Interview 2

Intro

- Used to trade on DEXes a lot - trading quite regularly - HydraDX, Bifrost, Stellaswap
- On Eth and Uniswap - he was also providing liquidity, but later on he quited due to impermanent loss

DEX experience

- Liquid staking vDOT - Instant redeem vDOT-DOT pool regularly increase - stable swap - Bifrost (no bonding period) staked DOT there
- DCA feature - trade larger amount - not getting dumped all at once rather gradually takes 20min period to trade it into small pieces, arbitrage and get the ratio where it's supposed to be - when I don't want to impact the price

v1 Feedback

- One swap DOT / DED
- Crosschain AH-PRC
- **Bug:** Adding liquidity 500 DED - got a message - Token frozen for DOT - DED
- Pretty simple interface, fast crosschain
- Add feature: combining crosschain and swap into one step - now you need to provide DOT from relay chain to Asset Hub. In future it can be both executed in one flow. Dropdown menu like asset and chain and then swap or so - without moving both.

v2 Feedback

Dashbaord

- Foreign Assets it's a bit confusing - why are they on all chains, what chains? Expand or show more or balances on other chains
- Why swap and transfers are only available for Asset Hub? Shouldn't transfer be available on Relay Chain as well?
- Other Assets - is that for LP tokens or so?
- Graph - last 7 days chart it does not have any number, it's not precise so I would get rid of it

- Important things before you want to swap:
 - Looking into different things about the project, e.g how is DED doing, what's with the ecosystem, community - nothing to include into this interface
 - Keep interface as clear as possible

Swap

- Countdown: not that valuable, it's only important to prevent error.
- It will be better to have settings page - set your preference for tokens to pay for gas
- Gas icon is not clear - He assumed is token amount on the Relay Chain or all chains combined
- If I swap non-USD assets I do only care about their ratio - how many DED can you get for DOT. USD view does not have much value unless you are trading in the stable coin.
- Default view should be native to native - what's USD price for DED

Pools

- Not very clear on LP tokens - how much do I have
- **Volatility** - how to help people figure out if impermanent loss is coming - VIX - should be high when DED-DOT / USDT-USDC is low (30 days or so)
- Withdraw liquidity: It does not tell me anything about the number of LP tokens - on the lower part of the page we should display that - convert it to how many LP tokens you are essentially selling

Crosschain

- You can edit AH address - whether is this my own address? Maybe we should only allow corsschain between your own accounts - usually it's from your own account. Sign - this is corresponding address to this wallet or so. Corresponding addresses (doubt on if this is my adress

Wrap up

- How we differentiate from other existing DEXes - I haven't seen anything that you canm not do on HydraDX, or Stella Swap - that's the biggest question. - It's just another DEX.
- Reward: Polkadot wallet on Polkadot Asset Hub (sent via email)

Interview 3

Intro

- Parachain leadership - Gaming. Kusama and Polkadot / BG in Finance -
- Dex expertise: Personally not use DEXes too much, not using nowadays swaps. Only using Hydration. Polkadot is the only chain with liquidity nowadays.

v1 Feedback

- Tried to do it straight from AH without relay chain tokens - figured out that these are two processes
- UI is clean that's cool, but if I look on Dashboard I don't see the pools anywhere, to see it on the side I could not find them. So I want to move pools from there to the left side bar.
- Create asset - under advanced features - create assets or create pools
- Use Case: Parachain token - help people register their foreign asset

v2 Feedback

Dashboard

- All tokens and 7d
- Volume of DOTs of the DEX - how much DOT was traded or DED traded etc.
- Foreign Assets - what's the difference between foreign assets and other assets and top assets
- The balance is the most important - so assets should be in that order on the Dashboard - available assets - don't show the tokens that are less than zero.
- Transfer for PAH and should you have it on PRC? Do you even need need transfer since that happens in wallet?
- Token Fees Switcher is cool.

Swap

- Indications on the volume is important - to figure out the scale of the value.

Pools overview

- Create new pool - and that's add liquidity - choose your token

Crosschain

- Existential deposit information
- We should mentioned in the route Bridge Hub as well, since snowbridge is just a pallet.
- Is there going to be different bridges and possibilities? Low gas fee, medium gas fee, low gas fee - research it out
- Is user going to be able to see his bridging transaction that's pending if he close the browser and come back? Do it with indexer for all events and see if this account had an event of a transaction on Ethereum crosschain. This way we can show it if it's open. Research for Subscan history as well.

Create Assets

- Add some explanations to the process and to the fields user should edit.
- Asset symbol, decimals - what's usually the the no of decimals, used for tokens
- Minimum Balance - explain what it is etc.
- We lack a screen with transaction fee
- Figure out how we can add

Wrap up

- Create pool with all the assets that exist
- People that are new can stick with the v1, and we can have some advanced view with other features - PRO version

Interview 3

Intro

- Have been in the web3 from the product side - product designer at Bifrost dapp. First worked as UI designer. Besides that he is in product manager roles on some external project aside from Bifrost for 3 years.
- Trading info
 - Bifrost (Polkadot)
 - Uniswap (Regular DEX he is using) - every week
 - Features he uses - swapping, adding some liquidity
 - Liquidity farming not a fan - I can't see my impermanent loss
 - New feature he wish to see someday: LP value change history - observe value change in the LP

v1 Feedback

- He didn't test the crosschain
- Cross in and cross out are misplaced
- Everything worked well
- Default for swap info should be for additional collapsed information to be visible.
- Add liquidity - I lack information on how much LP tokens I will get.
- LP tokens should be also visible on dashboard, with its USD value with action button - remove liquidity or add liquidity

v2 Feedback

Dashboard

- Notifications - should be pending on the notification
- Foreign assets - assets from other parachains, what does it mean all chains
 - We need to connect to all existing parachain node - if you connect too much at the same time, it costs much more CPU and it's slower. When

user needs to read data from the chain, then connect to it. This may be a problem maybe it will be better to do it with a service.

- Other assets - not clear on what networks does those exist, besides Asset Hub? It's technically challenging to connect to the each RPC for each network we support to show it. Suggestion was to do it through service.

Swap

- It's on the right side of the screen for review swap - I am more focused.
- Countdown was not necessary.

Pools

- First I want to see TVL to swap for low price impact
- Add search function - for pair I want to add liquidity
- Label for pools where you have liquidity, it's not intuitive to click on each pool to get details.
- Remove liquidity - enter it by user, by default to be set to empty input fields. Have MAX button. Show LP tokens.

Crosschain

- What is the cost for the whole process?

Interview 4

Intro

- BD and onboarding teams into Polkadot ecosystem - Polkadot Ambassadors / helping navigate PKLD ecosystem - open governance - DC voices - Open Gov involved - She test everything that's available - wallets etc.
- DEX experience
 - Not active too much on DEXes
 - Uniswap in 2020, currently she is not really into trading
 - Using often CEXes as it's a part of the operations - Binance, Kucoin
 - HydraDX - next in the row to check out

v1 Feedback

- Straightforward, minimalistic, clean
- Crosschain is not too clear for newbies because of terminology when they see it in the navigation bar. Since they don't understand correlation Moonbeam, Polkadot, HydraDX etc. it can be confusing to them to come here and see all of them and not know what to do. Some additional information will be helpful. Maybe change the terminology from crosschain to transfer - to remind more of a banking terminology everyone knows.
- Origin chain fee and destination chain free - you need total fee
- Polkadot breakdown - not intuitive - move the arrow by the token icon. Like this it seems it's only on Asset Hub.
- Clarify user message: too low trading minimum - DED - USDT
- Clarify user message: Destination account can not exist with swapped funds.
- Dashboard: part of the menu a bit bigger, lower icons, bigger actions I can perform from dashboard

v2 Feedback

Dashboard

- Looking good, not sure for small graph if it's relevant for non-traders. People coming for particular swap and tokens are only interested into balances, and price, not graph and what happened through time. So for me price is enough.

Swap

- Countdown is a cool feature when you ran out of fee.
- I would move swap on the left side and graph on the right side - that's supporting information for the user.
- Label somehow your pools - on which you can click to overview
- Message arriving in 45min - didn't catch her eye

Wrap up

- Reward: Polkadot wallet on Polkadot Asset Hub

Interview 5

Intro

- Builder in Polkadot ecosystem - around 5 years
- Tooling, substrate - in crypto journey more than 10 years
- DEX experience
 - Not a trader, but he knows the basic since he is in the web3 for long time.
 - Using Uniswap and similar (outside Polkadot)
 - Acala, Hydration, Polkaswap
- What is the main challenge you face with that DEX? When did you face it last time and how did you resolve?
 - Need for swapping for some Asset that is easier to **cash out**
 - **High volatility of the market** - good time to **withdraw** due to fluctuation
 - When adding liquidity, due to impermanent loss, I only add if there is some loyalty program to protect me.

v1 Feedback

- Quite seamless experience - he knew he needed to bring DOT to AH - maybe we should highlight that
- Crosschain transfer: no problem with that
- Swap: Changed DED to stablecoin
- Added to pool

v2 Feedback

Dashboard

- Price graph is nice to see
- KSM is nice to see - it won't be wKSM it will be KSM, same with ETH
- **DOT balance dropdown not that clear**
- Where are other assets - besides listed assets on the top?
- Where are other pools - besides listed pools?
- Combine Other Assets with Assets - since those are relevant equally

Pools

- **Add indicator for my liquidity**

Crosschain

- Bridge Fees - how much does it cost, since it's expensive, that's important information
- Breakdown Fees structure
- Block hash we share after bridging - when we send it, it will be destination block hash and when it arrives in the notification blockhash from destination chain should be visible

Create Pool

- The flow was clear to him
- Familiar with adding pools and liquidity - tokens, amounts, confirming
- At the end maybe LP tokens or what is your share of the pool
- Percentage and LP token I have in the pool

Create Asset

- Asset decimals - show it with some comma to be more intuitive
- 1,00 MICHEAL
- Assign a random asset ID or just unique ID so user does not have to choose it
- Show better it's a few steps flow
- Wallet address for minting tokens (it should be clear)
- Make different section that's about managing assets

Wrap up

- Keep things simple
- Swaping without extra surprises
- Creating the asset - I don't know if can be simpler so other stuff you fo later on - this is my token, how much I want to mint and that's it.
- Adding logo for the token

- Reward: Polkadot wallet on Polkadot Asset Hub

v1 Feedback

- Everything went great.
- The only issue was after crosschain when he clicked somewhere on the screen succes message closed and he didn't catch blockhash or anything. So he had to manually look for his transaction on Subscan.

V2 Feedback

Dashboard

Notes:

- Doesn't know what Other Assets are
- Understands the changing gas token - finds it impressive
- When swapping - he does his due diligence first. He doesn't need graph because he's making his decisions differently then daily traders
- Confused about the message for automatically changing gas fee and with the countdown.

Swap & Pools

- Doesn't like that pools are hidden inside swap page
- He would prefer Pools to be in the navigation
- Would like to see impermanent loss

- Help liquidity provider by explaining impermanent loss

Crosschain

- Easily performed the task
- Would like to see total fees instead of origin/destination
- Eth Bridge:
- Haven't see 45 minutes
- Not familiar with signing transaction on ethereum
- Confused with confirm spending gap - doesn't trust the message from Metamask
- Would like to see something on the UI about spending gap

Create Pool

- Easily created pool
- Would like to see how many LP tokens he get

Create Asset

- He likes the feature very much - you are making something very hard, very simple and accessible by anyone.
- However, it's a strategic decision should something like this be implemented in Polkadot ecosystem.

Interview 8

Intro

- Product Manager outside of Polkadot eco at Stablecoin issuer Brale
- Using DEXes and CEXes daily
- Not active user of Polkadot
- DEX profile: Using Uniswap, Velodrome, rarely: Balancer & Trader Joe
- Features: Swap, Concentrated Liquidity (liquidity management side)

v1 Feedback

- Very comfortable, did several swaps
- Bug: input field with entering decimals when .01
- Cross in - not familiar with the term
- Usually would click on explorer link while waiting for transaction
- Haven't realized there is a minimum amount for crossing out
- Wasn't immediately sure where to find pools but found it few moments after. He expects to see Pools in the navigation bar
- Understands where to find his liquidity share
- Wonders where LP reward would show
- Remove liquidity toaster should not have arrow ->
- [Dashboard]
 - Thought Asset List is list of Major tokens
 - Surprised that there is no other assets
 - Not sure why only DOT can be cross-chained
- Overall impression:
 - Very comfortable and what he expected to see compared to other 10-15 DEXes he used

v2 Feedback

Dashboard

- Q: What is foreign assets. Probably not guessing because of lesser familiarity with Polkadot
- Easily understands where to find chain breakdown
- Understands transfer and crosschain
- Easily finds where to change the token
- Easily navigates to token full graph

Swap

- User performed the task with the ease
- I'm not sure he figured out the message for insufficient funds

Pools

- Understands he have some liquidity in the pool
- Would expect to see fees he already earned
- Performs withdrawal with the ease
- Understands the message of minimum amount
- Understands the amount in the gas fee dropdown button (probably because of his EVM experience)
- He didn't think too much about signing 2 transactions

Cross Chain

- Confused about the fees (doesn't care because of the small amount fee)
- He assuming the USDT is Hydra fee
- Cross chain going smoothly
- He likes to see amount of time
- Assumes Snowbridge is the bridge that is used for bridging but not familiar with it
- He's just going through signatures. If he's the first time user he will look in more details into it, later on he won't

Create asset

- Don't know what Asset ID is
- Not too familiar with the flow

Overall experience

- Swap & Liquidity stuff pretty familiar and comfortable

- Asset Issuance - never saw it on a DEX
- Finds Asset Dashboard interesting but not familiar with polkadot specific things

Yield Discussion

- USDC and USDT - add stake button if the user clicks on it he can learn about APR generating feature, so if he stakes we turn it into stUSDC, stUSDC (v3)
- If you want to unstake stUSDC stUSDT - claiming rewards should be determined
- How we get yield and mechanics - rebase tokens dynamic, EVM part, security issues? How stUSDC and stUSDT can be created as an asset - maybe by fall.
- Do open Gove once we set up proposal with Brala that was created in April
- Other way: Snowbridge from EVM imported so people bring over their USDC
- Issue rebasing yield-bearing stable token - but we'll have to exclude US
- Exact structuring is to figure out - what Brala can offer from API in the US
- When user stake he swaps USDC for stUSDT and when unstake it would be opposite direction
- 5% APY or so
- Is it possible to claim the yield or it has to be token that is rebasing?

Interview 9

Intro

- Joined Crypto in 2017 - woke up in 2021
- Then he became validator in Polkadot since that clicked with him
- Started YT channel for Polkadot validations
- Mangata Finance - **DEX parachain** on Kusama an POLkadot and he became marketing lead for them (2.5 years)
- Time insentivization the longer you provide the more you earn

v1 Feedback

- He was hoping about updating metadata - he likes it
- Easily finds out that his DOT is on relay chain
- Successfully submitted his crosschain
- Likes the progress bar
- Insufficient DOT error occurs (UI is not showing it so he had to refresh it)
- Edit button is slightly confusing for him
- Very irritated with Auto / Default slippage he's not clear how much is it
- Slippage is not working properly - rounding numbers
- "Two modals fighting for his attention" (Swap in modal)
- After swap is completed he does not need swap modal to be opened
- Total balance and token price is should have the hierarchy
- Label should have more contrast
- [Pools]
- He was looking for APR
- MAX would be nice
- Negative impression about slippage

v2 Feedback

Dashboard

- Data can be a little bit more readable
- This UI is competing with my wallet

- Foreign Assets - I guess I can cross them in or maybe if they are registered on the chain - move them around between chains
- Show my DOT on all my chains - or just the chains that you are supporting? Talisman shows all my DOT on all my chains
- My total assets value - I guess it's all the assets combined
- It reminds of Talisman, it's very similar to it. It reminds a bit of Bifrost UI as well.
- Gas fee token - dashboard wouldn't be the screen where I should find it and do it - it will be the screen where I would need it - **Swap.**

Swap

- Graph: It should show DOT in USD - it was not clear that it was showing it in USD when no token selected. He likes that and he likes it shows volume which is more than typically.
- Insufficient fee funds message - why did this just happened - I missed it - I only had 5 sec. **Better approach:** ask user to change the gas token if he does not have enough.
- Graph DED - DOT: If I sell 1 DOT how many DED would I get - shouldn't there be opposite view on the graph? DOT vs DED. Make a switcher so it's possible to change graph and their places.

Pools

- **DOT should be on the right side since it is a based asset** - more important asset
- usually capitalized asset is the one on the right side
- Sort by TVL is nice
- I don't see any indication that I should interact with the pool - maybe small chevron or so
- My liquidity - why it was hidden before?
- Not sure if we need slippage icon there and I don't know if it's minimum received it's just received
- Check the balance - most of the time I am double checking - I would go to see my balance to check if it happened before

Create Pool

- All good

Crosschain

- Ethereum <> PAH: I lack information what bridge interface I am using

- When I am using a DEX a DEX is using another Bridge - it's using snowbridge it's trustless. Know this information right up front - are you scamming me right now?
- Previous Bridge transactions - that can help a lot - Bridge activity - to track it.
- Current balance on the chain where I am sending it is not necessary.
- At the beginning it's important to develop the trust - so I maybe never end up on the next screen if I don't know what bridge you guys are using. I am never getting to the step 2 because I could not figure out what bridge you are using.

Create Asset Hub token

- Creator account - this is basically me, why should I choose it - Owner account
- Needs some explanation for each role, each info
- Autoselect - asset ID
- I am missing supply - it's helpful to set the supply and mint it to the issuer
- This is basically mint tokens - it was not clear it's a 2 step process
- Why can't I see my created assets on the top of the Dashboard?
- Burn tokens is missing
- I am not sure if admin can influence other accounts?

Retrospective

- UI clean, works
- Register your asset from your parachain as foreign asset. Use case is used for teams that are supplying liquidity and wanting to create new assets - so we should focus on them.

Interview 10

Intro

- Started web3 end of 2020 - crypto summer. Hoped in for yield farming and rebasing stable coins
- For 9 months hustling with that and then it became very exhausting
- After that he entered NFTs and then decided to join a team and help building something
- Then he joined Talisman in 2022 - COO
- Working on multisig wallet and managing finances Ethereum and then on Polkadot
- Last 6-9 months Currently building enterprise workload management - helping foundations manage crypto treasuries and manage portfolios
- Currently - ended with Talisman working on different Polkadot initiatives

DEXes experience:

- Not so much interactions recently with DEXes
- He is more like an investor, not swapping regularly - buy, hold and stake more like - it's too trouble too many wallets managing etc.
- Hydration was his favorite but not too much

v1 Feedback

- When user has only one account on the wallet, there is no need for choose account step. It should be by default when he connects.
- Other Assets - permissionless - random assets that have been created - whole bunch of other coins or other assets that come in
- It's strange that we have Dashboard as a first page - that's more like a wallet experience - so I need to be grounded on swap feature.

- Pools is pretty standard
- It was not intuitive for him that he needs to send DOT to Asset Hub to see balances in swap
- Bug with input - output box
- Slippage custom button was not intuitive to him to click to set his own slippage - he thought it didn't working
- Lock pools if they don't have a pair - it didn't work - I could have dot and DED in the pair but I might have LP tokens
- Cross out - not used to the phrase
- It's weird it's universal address - it should be the Polkadot address
- Checking analytics to do swap
- First graph - weird data - analytics should follow at current date - seeing the late date is old and bad
- I have no idea what this is and why it's linked to analytics - it does not reflect well cause it's not current

- When I see this and assume these assets on Asset Hub - it's weird the asset Hub is on the top
- Talisman: DOT broken up on several chains - to help me use DOTswap I need to have it on Asset Hub so it's helpful to know what of this is not on Asset Hub
- Dashboard buttons should be disabled if I don't have that token

Like a Uniswap it feels set - people would be forgiving a little things here and there Cross in and Cross out is a bit weird, unless it becomes standard polkadot thing - or maybe it is

It does everything as expected - it works, I will be able

Interview 11

Intro

- Performing swaps usually - daily but he is not advanced user. Currently when it's volatile market - once a week.
- DeFi Doubler - someone who like DeFi.
- Not a Uniswap v3 fan
- Sometimes giving the LP
- HydraDX most used in Polkadot ecosystem, Stellaswap and Uniswap.
- Fan of Kujira ecosystem - Cosmos SDK - everything you need on a single chain - money market, LP provision, swaps, landing etc. He likes Hydra since they are moving to that direction.
- He finds Uniswap v2 inefficient - going to infinity on both sides of the asset if it's a volatile asset
- Favorite conditions: stable swap pool incentivized by a DEX - USDC, USDC. **Steady stream of passive income**
- Impermanent loss is never an issue in these kind of set ups - you can minimize risk and IL - even if it's 0.1% or so
- He swaps when the market is volatile - stables for an asset or so

v1 Feedback

- Crosschain:
 - Cool to have crosschain it in the app
 - Check Nova wallet for some ideas
 - Notifications are slow due to the network - Polkadot is very slow - 6 seconds
 - Bug - inputbox it didn't autopopulate with 1 after he switched from USDT to USDC
 - Simple and intuitive UI
 - He wanted to create pool USDC - USDT pool
 - He is not closing the pop up
 - He assumed it's Uniswap v2

- Edit gas token fee - in the wallet - gas pump, every asset
- Suggestion: at a glance it would be better to list both Asset Hub and Relay Chain
- He assumed that once set gas token will be set for all transactions - add liquidity
- It's a great start - limited functions on Asset Hub
- Talk for long time: People have said swap functionality have been there for a year, and no UI for it. Biggest push back is **that there are other DeFi chains that have all this functionality.**
- How we will getting funding when other projects already exist and have that functionality?
- Joe Petrowski - take DOT off the relay chain and make AH chain for all tokens - place for issuance and all tokens
- Materials to do everything on Asset Hub is there, but challenge is to move and come over to AH
- If we ever achieve direct AH payment rails and have native USDC and not
- Single side liquidity provisions on Hydra is very good and interesting - effectively farming HDX tokens 25% APY accumulating / same with Bifrost and others - deposit and don't worry of IL / if we are on the place where everything is on AH

v2 Feedback

- All the assets at your disposal on Asset Hub - one location (as we talked) Everything is there. If it's truly the Hub it needs all the assets
- Ability to select your payment token - noticeable
- wKSM - it's not supposed to be wrapped
- Other assets - any assets that exists on Asset Hub or snow-fork bridge - if AH can be central repository for EVM chain tokens (ERC-20)
- Graphs - not familiar too much. Dumping airdrops to stables. If you are arbitrator this could be super useful - price on Asset Hub is different on Uniswap or so
- Gas paying token - HydraDX - he hit the max button - it deducted that small amount the payment and it went through
- New asset - Polkasassembly OpenGov - create treasury proposal

Intro

- Hydration - before Stella swap. Crosschain transfers via Moonbeam.
- Outside - Coinbase.
- Weekly - twice - change across or similar. Much easier to keep everything at one place - like CEXes - record keeping. Labeling etc.
- Features: crosschain transfer s - moving liquidity around, staking - but not really a DEX thing. I don't do liquidity provision. If it's one sided- USDC and USDT only then but I don't. I've done a major ones early on - Eth - USDC. I don't even know if I earn - it was hard to understand did I make more Eth or USDC - at the end of the day was there impermanent loss. Hard to keep track the actual amount.

Intro

- Co-Founder & CEO of Velocity Labs, former DeFi Lead Ecosystem Development at Parity
- Velocity Labs: Ensuring partners such as wallets, CEXs, On/Off Ramps, Custodians and Asset Issuers are providing and improving their support for the ecosystem as a whole.
- Also he is DeFi Bounty Curator Lead - he will present DOTswap proposal to curators
- DEX profile: not a meme coin trader or intraday trader. Simple process since he is dollar-cost averaging type of trader. I come constantly and buy small chunks of assets I feel okay keeping - Eth, Bitcoin, USDC etc.

v2 Feedback

- Showing total balance and its breakdown by chains is much cleaner than showing different balances on each chain
- He does not like Foreign assets - user should not know if those assets are foreign or whatever
- Other Assets - maybe LP tokens, but I don't know what should that be. He is a bit confused
- Transfer and crosschain are potentially the same thing - moving assets - figure out if that will be a good solution to combine those two
- He does not make a trading decision based on the graph however it is useful to give you a sense on what is happening of market movements - usually DEXes does not give you that information
- It would be cool to have all fees expressed in USD
- Volume: 7 days average, 1 day average etc.
- Gas alert and edit - not fully intuitive
- Pools: total assets - percentage of the pools (70% DOT and 30% USDC)
- Incentives - real number and composition for the APRs (in future once we have incentives)
- Add for your position - earned fees (e.g. Nova wallet brakes it down to how much you pooled and how much you earned)
- Crosschain: Move information regarding fees, time, bridge up front

- Later on focus **liquidity**: On-ramping - Banxa, Ramp Network, Mercurio, Alchemy Pay, also player that will aggregate all of them. This will be important for bringing liquidity to Asset Hub.
- Network Hub - **second important thing**
