In preparation for testing, it is important to remember, that ***the state assessments are secure tests. Unauthorized electronic devices*** like watches, cameras, and cellphones may not be worn in the testing sites. ***Health monitoring devices require specialized seating*** and that special need should be shared with your school before testing begins to ensure that a 504 plan is in place. If a student is removed due to unauthorized use of technology, it must be proved that they did not capture and share the secure questions. Students will be made aware of the security plan and will be expected to cooperate. Those that ***violate the plan will be subject to disciplinary action according to school policy*** and may have their assessment voided. The goal is to provide an optimum testing environment for all students to perform well without disruptions.
