

Title: Center Alignment, 1 Space Line Spacing, 14pt Font Size, Bold Font Style, Capitalize Each Word

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Abstract (10pt)

Provide 1 space line of 12pt above the abstract title. The abstract must provide brief information to readers about the contents of the paper and must contain at least 70 and at most 200 words. The abstract should be arranged in 10pt font size, 1 space line spacing, and left-right aligned with 1 centimeter indentation from the left and right margin boundaries. Do not include table numbers, figure numbers, and references in the abstract. At the bottom of the abstract, there are keywords and no more than 5 words that are alphabetically arranged. Provide 1 line of 10pt before writing the keywords.

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INTRODUCTION (13pt)

Provide 2 spaced 12pt lines above the introduction title. The word "Introduction" in the title should be written in uppercase. The introduction covers the background, current situation, formulation of the problem, and research objectives. The content of the introduction is written in 12pt font size. Every foreign term should be italicized. Everything is written in Times New Roman font with 1 spaced line. The first paragraph for each section is not indented. To be safe, please follow this template, do not modify it, fill/place your writing directly in this template. Modifying this template can cause format inconsistency.

The second and subsequent paragraphs are indented first line up to 0.6 cm. We ask authors to follow the guidelines described in this example for consistency (Brown et al., 2019). Papers that are technically incompatible with the guidelines will be returned by the editor for correction or retyping. After being returned, the manuscript must be modified properly and in accordance with the guidelines. Provide 1 spaced 12pt line above the sub-introduction 1 title. The sub-introduction word in the title should be written with Capitalize Each Word. The content of the sub-introduction is also written in 12pt font size. We highly recommend that authors use this document to prepare for the camera-ready process. Please follow the instructions carefully to make the volume look as uniform as possible (Clements & Sarama, 2020).

Please remember that all writing must be consistent and without spelling errors. Citations in the content should use the American Psychological Association (APA) style, and it is recommended to use programs such as Mendeley or others.

Provide 1 line spacing of 12pt above the title of Sub Introduction 1. The words "Sub Introduction" in the title should be capitalized. The content of the sub-introduction should also be written in 12pt font size. We highly recommend authors to use this document to prepare for the camera-ready process. Please carefully follow the instructions to make the volume look as uniform as possible (Clements & Sarama, 2020).

Please note that all writing must be consistent and free of spelling errors. References/citations within the content should use the American Psychological Association (APA) style, and it is recommended to use programs such as Mendeley or others.

Sub Introduction 2 (12pt)

Provide 1 line spacing of 12pt above the title of Sub Introduction 2. The paper should not include a literature review, but it is acceptable to include the theoretical framework of the research. Make sure that your paper idea is not plagiarism.

RESEARCH METHOD (13pt)

Before writing the title of the research method, give a 2-space distance with 12pt line spacing. In this section, you are asked to explain the method, model, design, subjects, and location of the research you conducted. You may also include the research procedure you used in a way that is easy for readers to understand. Make sure the method is correct (David, Teddlie, & Reynolds, 2019). All cited sources are for example only. The Method section should be concise, but it should include sufficient technical information to enable the experiment to be repeated by qualified readers. Only new methods need to be described in detail. Cite previously published procedures in the References.

Farikhah & Ariestina (2020) stated that this is an example of a writing template to be submitted to the publication section of the Jurnal Ilmu Pendidikan (JIP) STKIP Kusuma Negara. Please follow the instructions as well as possible so that the article in the conference has the same writing format.

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION (13pt)

Before writing the title of the results and discussion, give a 2-space distance with 12pt line spacing. The results of the study are a description based on the types of data collected according to the research method. The results and discussion must be consistent. This section can be separated into "Research Results" and "Discussion" respectively.

Sub Results and Discussion 1 (12pt)

Give a 1-space distance with 12pt line spacing above the title of sub results and discussion 1. The results should include the rationale or experimental design and the experimental results. The results can be presented in figures, tables, and text. Discuss the results yourself. Add a discussion that is definitely related to the Figure or Table.

In the discussion, there must be a citation/reference from other research results. Compare how your research results with relevant research.

Sub Results and Discussion 2 (12pt)

Give a 1-space distance with 12pt line spacing above the title of sub results and discussion 2. The discussion should be an interpretation of the results from the repetition of the results. Also, include appropriate references for your explanation. Do not use unnecessarily long explanations, use sentences that are in accordance with EYD (Flinn & Mulligan, 2019). Translated sentences are beautiful compositions. Do not write carelessly.

How about Table (12pt)

Give a 1-space distance with 12pt line spacing above the table title. Each table must be numbered with Arabic numerals (e.g., Table 1, Table 2) sequentially and include a caption. Tables must always be captioned above them. Text using single-spaced lines should be centered and should not make the same table but separate on two different pages. The font size used in the table is 11pt. The content of the table should not use bold lettering. Table text is not allowed to be created vertically. The table does not display vertical lines. Make it with 12pt line spacing above and below the table. Examples can be seen in Table 1.

Table 1 shows that the highest p-value is at Fz. Please continue the explanation. Note that the presented table must be cited. The table should be typed separately from the main text. Each column in a table should have a title, and abbreviations, if necessary, should be defined in footnotes.

How about Figure (12pt)

The grid and details in the image must be clearly readable and should not be written on top of each other. Each figure must be numbered with Arabic numerals (e.g., Figure 1, Figure 2) sequentially and include a caption. Do not present figures without explanations that can confuse readers. Use 12pt line spacing above and below the figure. An example can be seen in Figure 1.

Figures must be cited and provided separately from the main text. Use Arabic numerals to give all numbers (e.g., Figure 1, Figure 2) in order in the text. Multi-part numbers should be marked with letters (e.g., a, b, c, etc.) in parentheses on the figure itself. Add a certain discussion related to the presented figure. Show valid and reliable analysis in your paper. The presentation of data analysis results is also shown by including appropriate references. The use of sentences in the paper that contains plagiarism is a crime. Please repeatedly check your paper to avoid plagiarism.

How about Equation (12pt)

Equations should be placed on a separate line, numbered and centered. Extra line spacing should be added above and below the equation.

The corresponding numbers to the equations should appear sequentially in each section or in contributions, with the numbers enclosed in parentheses and set at the right margin, starting with number 1 and so on.

How about Reference (12pt)

This section is an explanation of the references. References and citations follow APA style (see the References section). You can consider citing (Farikhah & Ariestina, 2020), or Farikhah & Ariestina (2020). For four or more authors, use et al. from the first citation such as (Brown et al., 2019). For three authors, the first author is written as follows (David, Teddlie, & Reynolds, 2019), while the next ones are written as (David et al., 2019).

References should be typed with single line spacing and indentation for references whose writing exceeds 1 line is with hanging at 0.6 centimeters from the left margin.

CONCLUSION (13pt)

Provide 2 line spacing 12pt above the conclusion title. The conclusion must confirm the problem that has been analyzed in the results and discussion section. The conclusion is not numbered. Show that the conclusion is not a repetition of the research results but the beginning of the emergence of implications. We hope you find the information in this template useful for preparing your paper submission.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT (13pt)

If any, should be placed before the reference section without numbering. Place the Acknowledgment, including information about the source of any financial support received for the published work.
