<p>Content Standard: Main: 2.1 Communicate simple information intelligibly</p> <p>Complementary: 4.2 Communicate basic information intelligibly for a range of purposes in print and digital media</p>		<p>Pre-lesson: Teacher asks pupils if they use their gadgets outside of their home. Pupils share their answers. Lesson delivery:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Teacher asks pupils other than studies and lessons, what do pupils use their gadgets for. Pupils share their answers. 2. Pupils are asked if they know what will happen if pupils use gadgets excessively. Teacher can ask a pupil to write down other pupils' ideas on the board / present screen. 3. Teacher shows examples how pupils can write and explain how they can use their gadgets wisely. In their exercise books, pupils share their answers in graphic organisers. <p>Post-lesson: Pupils share the importance of using gadgets wisely. Pupils add on another graphic organizer.</p>
