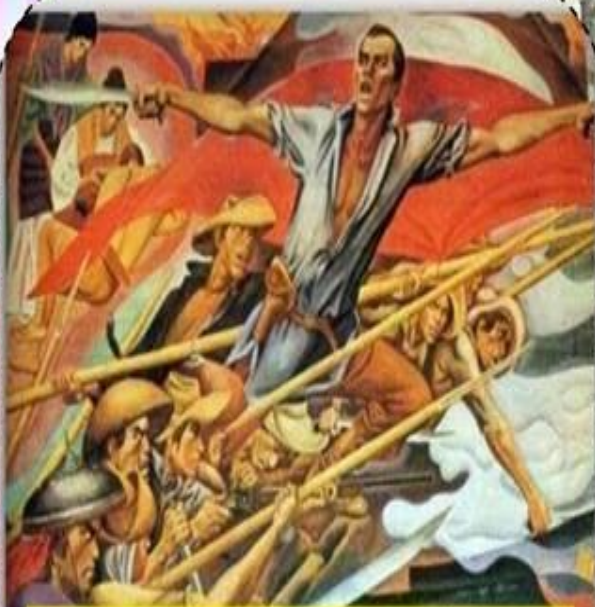

What is a fraction?

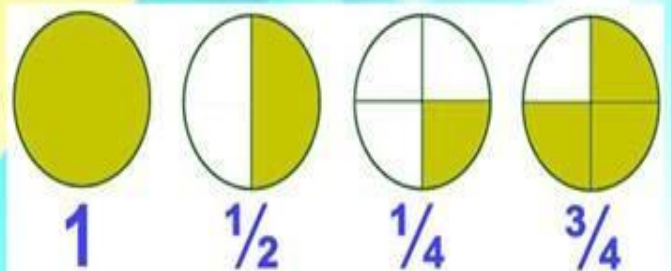
Fractions name parts of a whole.

We call the top number the **NUMERATOR**; it is the number of parts you have.



We call the bottom number the **DENOMINATOR**; it is the number of parts the whole is divided into.



Multiply the
numerators

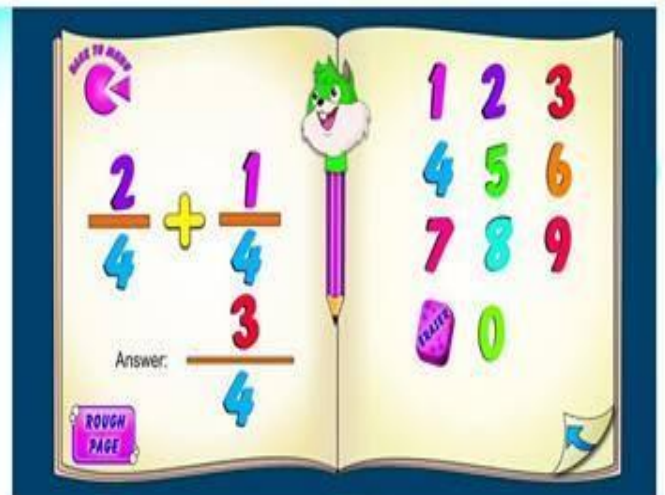
$$\frac{2}{5} \times \frac{3}{4} = \frac{6}{20}$$

Multiply the
denominators

$$\frac{2}{5} \times \frac{3}{4} = \frac{6}{20}$$

Reduce the fraction if
necessary

$$\frac{6}{20} = \frac{3}{10}$$

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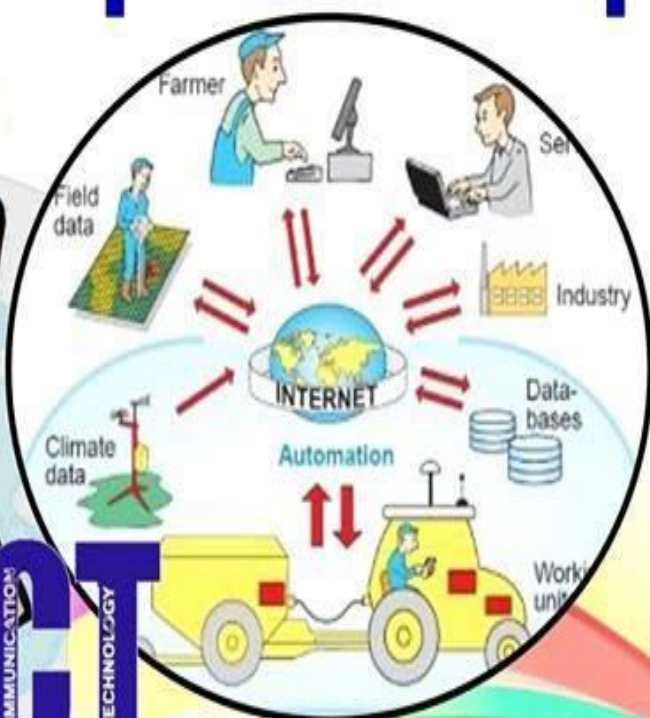
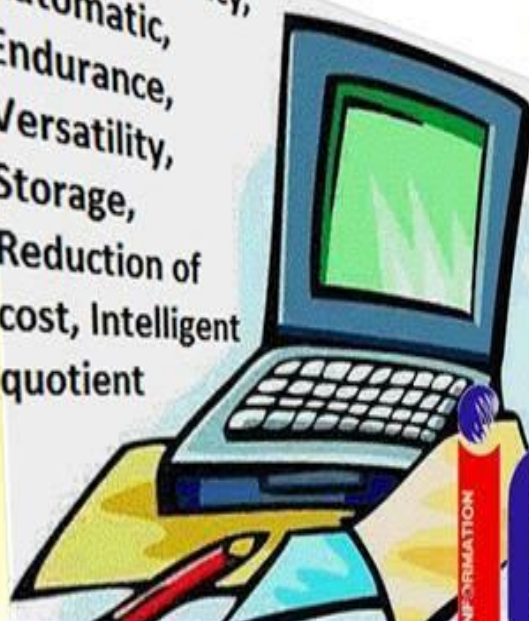
