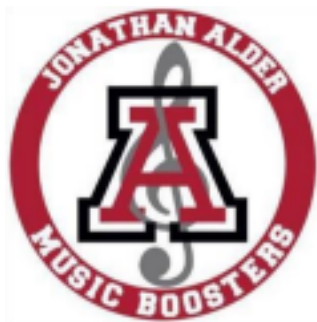

opportunity to perform at the Ohio Music
Education Association Solo and Ensemble
Adjudicated Event. This event is completely
voluntary and greatly encouraged for anyone
taking private lessons and will be held at **Pleasant
View Middle School (Grove City) on Saturday,
January 25th**. This is an all day event and times

for performances are determined as students sign up.

♦ Students who wish to participate will have the option to perform with either a solo & piano

accompanist or in a small group (3-5 students) in a like-instrument ensemble (ex. Brass Trio, Clarinet Quartet, etc.) Students will perform a selection

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from a list of pieces (see directors for list) for a state certified judge and each student will receive a rating and comments. ♦ Overall this is a fun day and a great experience where students have the chance to grow tremendously in their individual music performance! Students will be responsible for their own mode of transportation both to and from the event. There is a performance fee to cover the cost of the event. I have listed the costs below:

- **Solos will cost \$21 (plus cost of accompanist - to be provided by private instructor/student)**
- **Ensembles will cost \$26 but this cost is divided amongst the number of students performing in the ensemble (ex. a Woodwind Quartet (4 students) will pay \$6.50 each)**
- ♦ **Forms will be sent home next week and payment for the event is due no later than **Friday, Dec 13th**. Checks may be made payable to Jonathan Alder Music Boosters.*
- ♦ Performance times are released usually a week or two before the event. Unfortunately we do not have the option to choose the students' performance times as they are scheduled for us.
