## Powers:

Can emit a form of soft light with variable charge, temperature, shape and luminosity (within the limits provided below). With the exception of shape, the aforementioned properties must remain the same throughout. Up to 70 litres of material can be active at any one time, provided it is within 20 meters and line of sight. Control over the shape and movement of material requires intense concentration, and is considerably easier if both the shape and the manner of movement resemble a self-consistent natural form the cape can remember. For example, a small humanoid form moving at a realistic walking pace would be almost intuitive for the cape to control, but if it were to become less lifelike in form or move in a less natural way (faster than it could possibly run, or floating for instance) the cape would have to put in increasing amounts of effort in order to control that one form, impairing possible multitasking, effectiveness or coordination of the power. Forms or array of forms that deviate too far from intuitive control (e.g. an eldritch mass of flailing strands or a swarm of goat-headed pixies) force the cape to dedicate all of their attention to manipulating the substance, and so would be unable to move, speak, or concentrate on their surroundings and attempting to do so would disrupt their power. Formless constructs are less impaired by this than unnatural forms, but are still difficult to control while doing anything else. Non-animal forms such as leaves floating on the wind are also fine as intuitive forms, provided they move in the same direction that leaves would. A form that leaves the line of sight or range of the cape will appear to melt and will dissipate within a few seconds. The substance is produced from hands at up to 2L/s. It takes about half a minute to change the homogenous properties between extremes. It is translucent and opalescent in colour.

Note: the size of constructs is a lot less important than the shape they take, a tiny person or a cat-sized bug are both perfectly fine, though require some concentration. Both man-made objects, imaginary entities and things like geometric shapes count as unnatural forms. Forms are not hollow, and attempting to do so would be extremely difficult. Only the external appearance of a form is taken into account when constructing. The cape is immune to the effects of touching the soft light, but is otherwise no more resistant to electricity or temperature than normal, they have no innate ability to ignore the glare of their light. The light transmits temperature on contact as if it were a liquid. Not all of the substance has to move at the same speed.
