

Chromebook Camera Instruction

These are instructions on how to use the camera to take pictures.

1. Load the camera application.
 - a. Click on the “Search Circle” located in the bottom left corner of the screen as indicated in figure 1.

2. Click on the Camera icon if it is available or type “camera” in the search box provided and press ENTER. See FIGURE 2 and 3.

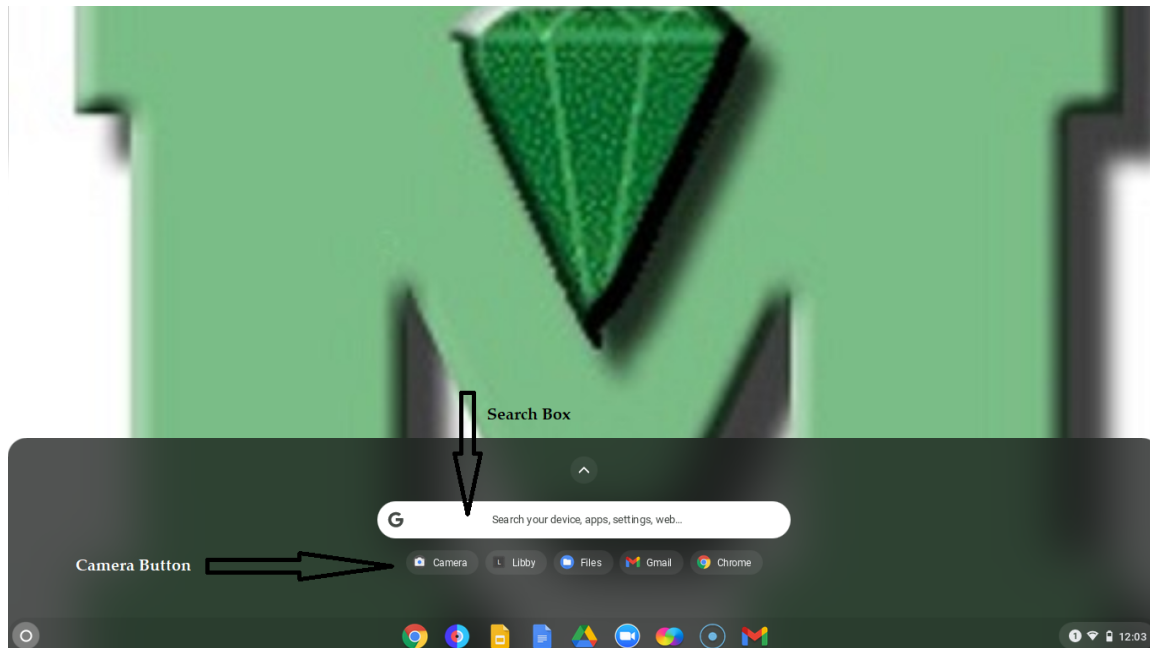

3. As shown in FIGURE 3 when you do a search it will bring up the Camera icon. Click on the Camera icon.

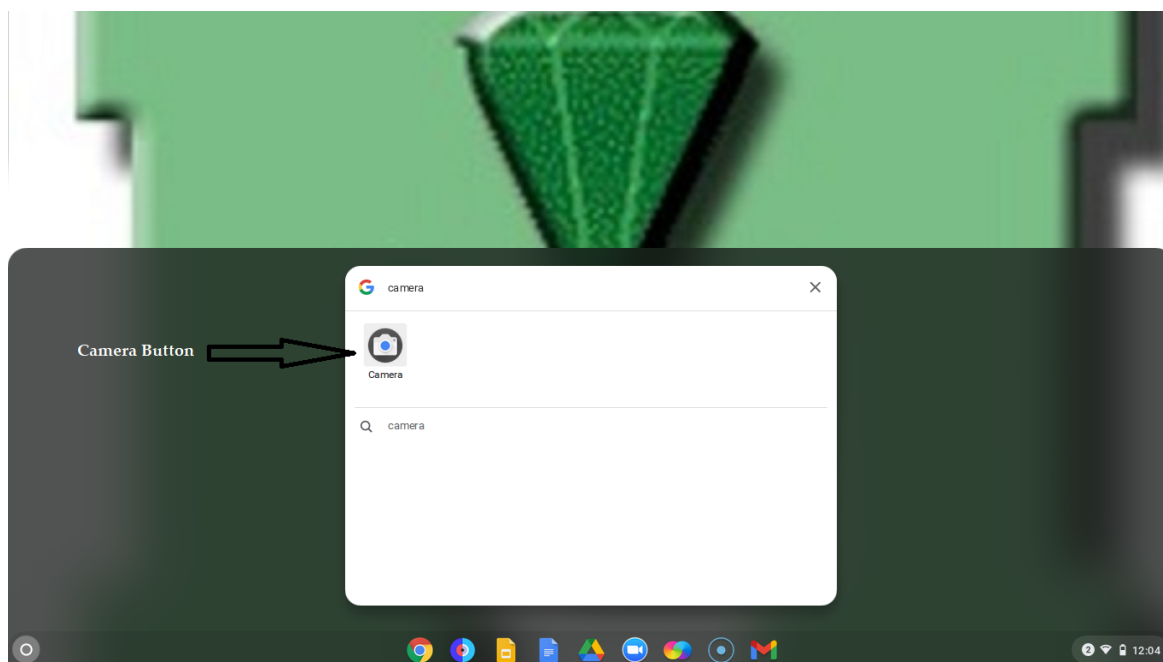

4. At this point the Camera should be on and you are able to hold anything in front of the camera that you would like to take a picture of. The camera lens is located in the center top of your screen.
5. As indicated in FIGURE 4, you will see the card that is held in front of the camera is backwards. To make it “forward” you must “mirror” the image. To do that you click on the mirror icon on the left side of the camera screen.
6. To snap a picture, you will click on the round button located on the right side of the camera screen as indicated below.
7. On the right side of the camera screen you will also find the Video/Picture selector, and this is how you would switch between capturing a picture or capturing a video.

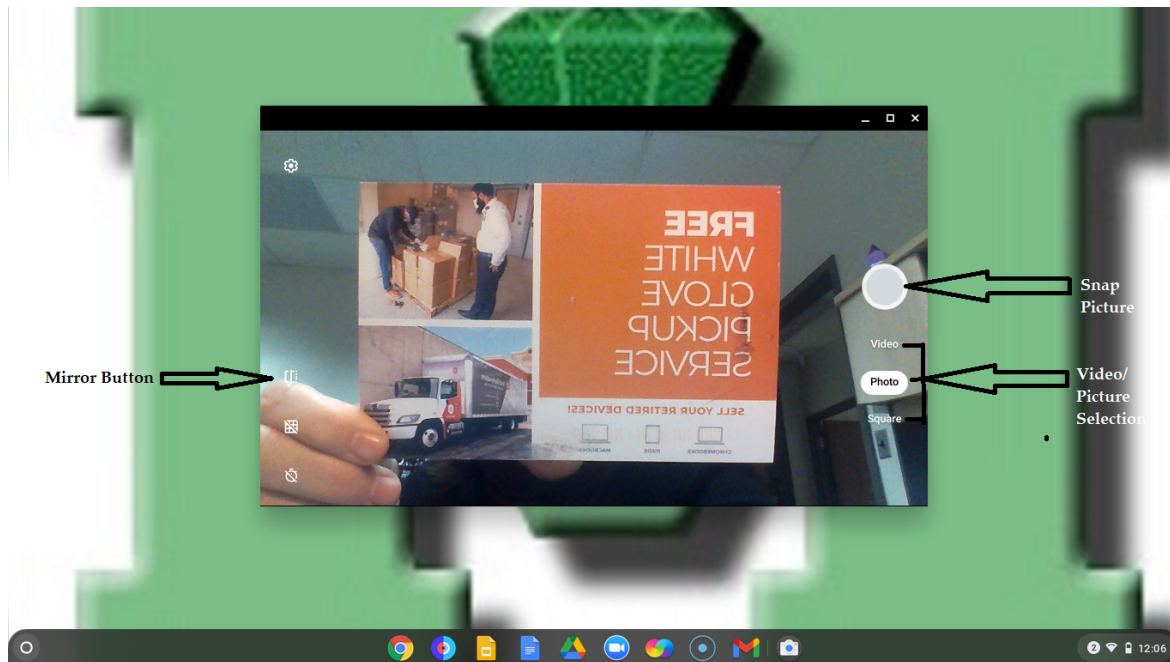

8. FIGURE 5 shows the image correctly displayed after pressing the Mirror button.

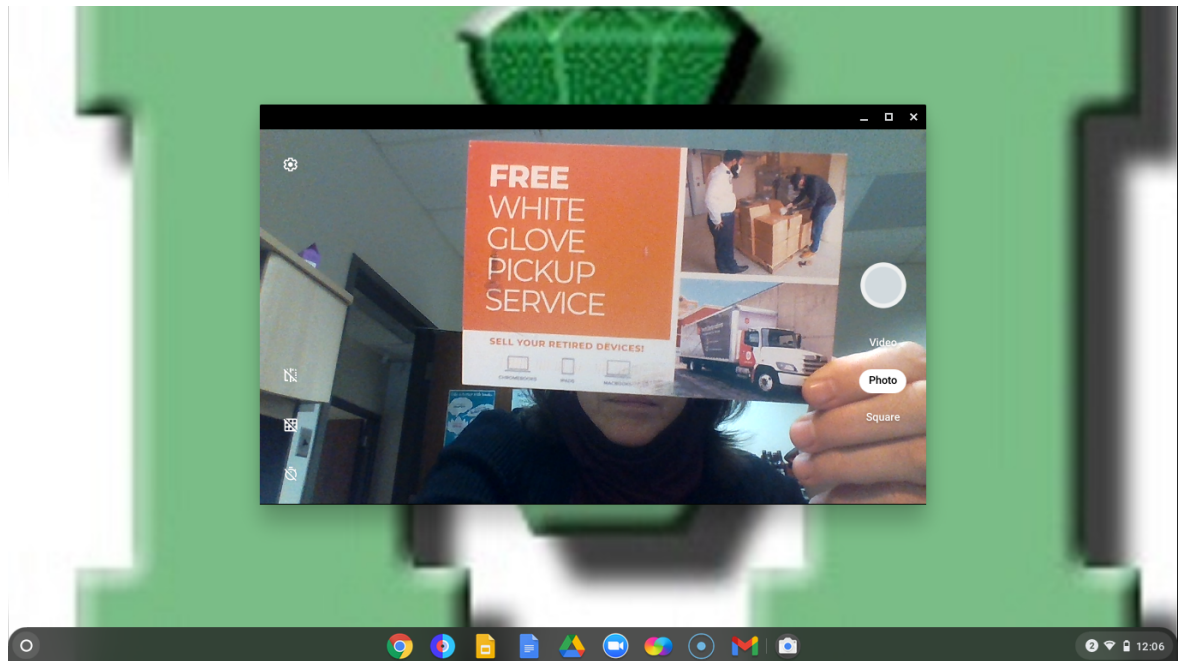
