Attention Parents/Guardians

IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS
Children in <u>ALL</u> grades will need the following in

2023-2024

- 4 doses of tetanus, diphtheria, and acellular pertussis* (One dose on or after the 4th birthday)
- 4 doses of polio (4th dose on or after 4th birthday and at least 6 months after previous dose given)**
- 2 doses of measles, mumps, rubella***
- 3 doses of hepatitis B (3rd dose must be given at 6 months or after)
- 2 doses of varicella (chickenpox) or history of the disease

*Usually given as DTP or DtaP or DT or Td

**A fourth dose is not necessary if the third dose was administered at age 4 years or older and at least 6 months after the previous dose

***Usually given as MMR

Additional requirements for 7th grade students:

1 dose of tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis (Tdap) 1 dose of meningococcal conjugate vaccine (MCV)

Additional requirements for 12th grade students:

1 dose of MCV (If one dose was given at 16 years of age or older, that shall count as the 12th grade dose)

These requirements allow for exemptions due to medical reasons, religious belief, or philosophical strong moral/ethical conviction. If your child is exempt from immunizations, they may be removed from school during an outbreak.
