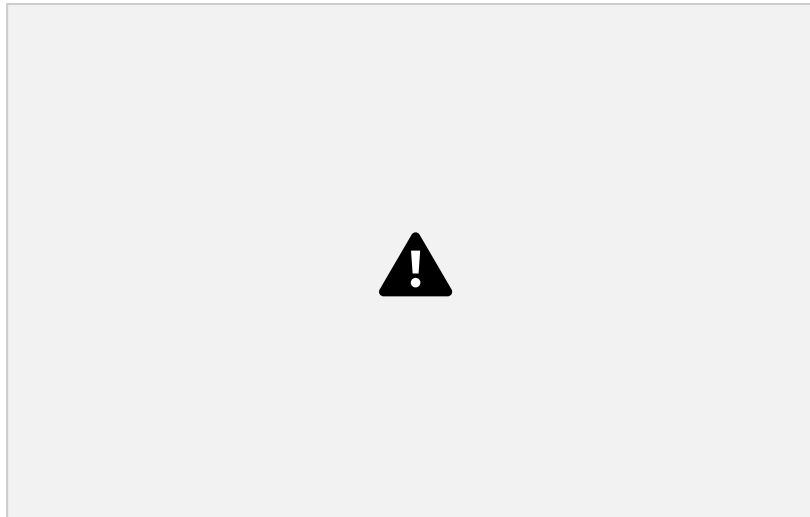
The event successfully strengthened youth engagement, encouraged collaboration, and enhanced leadership skills among participants, making the celebration meaningful and impactful for all involved.
