

 No research conducted. Not used Foundation Research Study template. 	 Conduct research. Use correct document template 	Documents are only denied when documents have conducted no research such as collecting samples or not using the Foundation Research Study template.

Poor

Minimum Requirements	Possible Improvements	Notes
 No Aim, Method, Conclusion. Minimal research conducted. No RP involved. Bad spelling, punctuation and grammar. 	Aim, Method, Conclusion included	This is the lowest grade. It is given out when no format is followed or the document is written terribly.

Average

Minimum Requirements	Possible Improvements	Notes
 Format followed. Reasonable aim Average conclusion Comprehensible spelling, punctuation and grammar. 	 Evidence of RP Descriptive method Suggests a use for findings 	This grade is handed out when a format is followed and the research is comprehensible but the research is either uninteresting or lacks evidence of roleplay.

 Descriptive aims and conclusion Few spelling, punctuation and grammar errors. Evidence of RP. Suggests use of findings. 	 Highly analytical and descriptive findings. Useful and purposeful research. 	Good is a grade handed out when a document has conducted good research and the document has clear aims of what the research intended to achieve.

Excellent

Minimum Requirements	Possible Improvements	Notes
 Highly descriptive aims, method and conclusion. Excellent use of grammar and very little spelling mistakes. Minimum 4 pages. Evidence of RP. Suggests use of findings. 	• N/A	Excellent documents must stand out. They should include very descriptive aims, method and conclusion in addition to the research being relatively creative/unique. A long document does not equal an Excellent document; as long as it is longer than 4 pages and is well laid out, it has the potential to be Excellent.
