



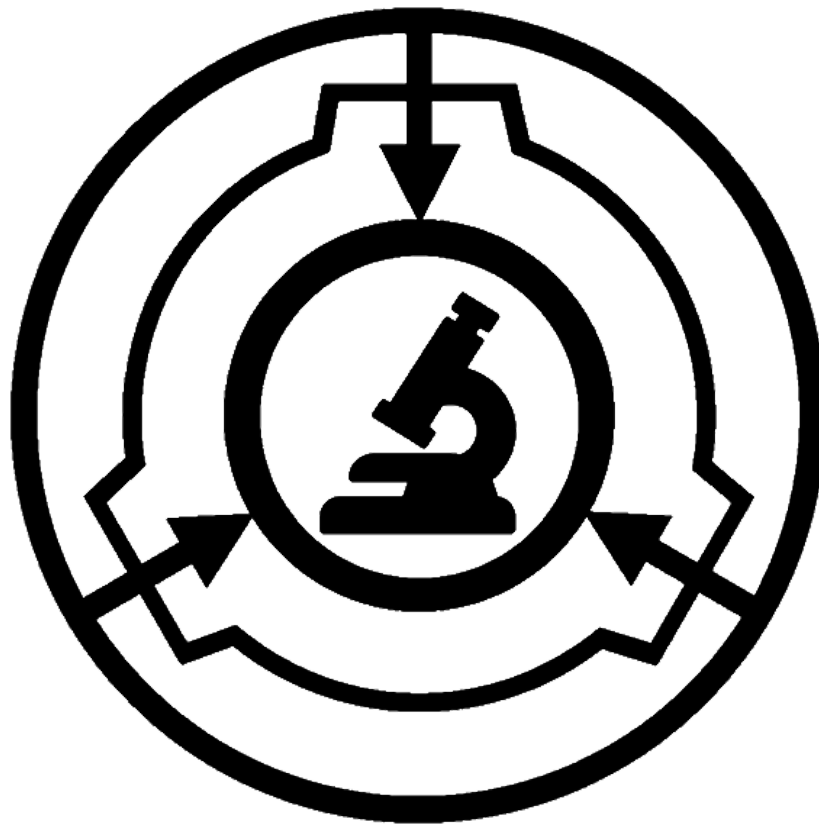

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## Gradings

### Denied

Minimum Requirements	Possible Improvements	Notes
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• No research conducted.</li><li>• Not used <i>Foundation Research Study</i> template.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Conduct research.</li><li>• Use correct document template</li></ul>	Documents are only denied when documents have conducted no research such as collecting samples or not using the <i>Foundation Research Study</i> template.

### Poor

Minimum Requirements	Possible Improvements	Notes
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• No Aim, Method, Conclusion.</li><li>• Minimal research conducted.</li><li>• No RP involved.</li><li>• Bad spelling, punctuation and grammar.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Aim, Method, Conclusion included</li></ul>	This is the lowest grade. It is given out when no format is followed or the document is written terribly.

### Average

Minimum Requirements	Possible Improvements	Notes
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Format followed.</li><li>• Reasonable aim</li><li>• Average conclusion</li><li>• Comprehensible spelling, punctuation and grammar.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Evidence of RP</li><li>• Descriptive method</li><li>• Suggests a use for findings</li></ul>	This grade is handed out when a format is followed and the research is comprehensible but the research is either uninteresting or lacks evidence of roleplay.

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## Good

Minimum Requirements	Possible Improvements	Notes
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Descriptive aims and conclusion</li><li>• Few spelling, punctuation and grammar errors.</li><li>• Evidence of RP.</li><li>• Suggests use of findings.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Highly analytical and descriptive findings.</li><li>• Useful and purposeful research.</li></ul>	Good is a grade handed out when a document has conducted good research and the document has clear aims of what the research intended to achieve.

## Excellent

Minimum Requirements	Possible Improvements	Notes
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Highly descriptive aims, method and conclusion.</li><li>• Excellent use of grammar and very little spelling mistakes.</li><li>• Minimum 4 pages.</li><li>• Evidence of RP.</li><li>• Suggests use of findings.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• N/A</li></ul>	Excellent documents must stand out. They should include very descriptive aims, method and conclusion in addition to the research being relatively creative/unique. A long document does not equal an Excellent document; as long as it is longer than 4 pages and is well laid out, it has the potential to be Excellent.
