Getting Ubuntu:

This summer, we'll be using Linux as the platform for development, namely Ubuntu 16.04. We'll install everything on the first day, but I wanted you to download the big files first, hopefully while you're still around fast internet connections. Here are some things to do:

- Go to <https://www.ubuntu.com/download/desktop> and download Ubuntu 16.04.2 LTS.
 - If the download above is really slow, try this link: <http://mirror.pnl.gov/releases/16.04.2/ubuntu-16.04.2-desktop-amd64.iso>
 - The file is about 1.5 GBs. Save it somewhere on your laptop, but you don't need to do anything with it now. We'll use it on day 1.

Getting the Virtual Machine Software:

- Be on the lookout for an email from noreply@kivuto.com. This email will have the info to create an account so you can download some software that you get for free for being a student.
 - create the account
 - Download VMware Fusion 8 if you're on a Mac or VMware Workstation 12 if you're on a PC.
 - Go ahead and install the software.
