ABSTRACT

The ability to read is the key to knowledge; Without reading skill, life can be nearly impossible. The future of today's learners depends on how well they understand and use a wide range of texts in a thoughtful way. It also relies on their ability to use reading skills to think critically and pass on orally and in writing their thoughts and opinions (Department of Education, 2013).

This study aimed to increase the reading level of Grade 1 – Salvie pupils from Full Refresher to Grade Ready. The use of letter tiles as an intervention was viewed by the teacher to be an extremely important component in increasing the reading level of grade one learners.

Letter tiles help explain reading and spelling concepts very clearly. Concepts and ideas become something pupils can see and manipulate. The different colors help pupils visualize the different roles that letters have. Research has shown that letter tiles and manipulatives are in invaluable tool to help students recognize spelling patterns in words.

Learners had also their individual Reading profile for an efficient way of tracking their reading progress.

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

As per the notes of the teachers in their Individual Reading Profile after the study, 20% were Full Refresher, 60% of the pupils were Moderate Refresher, 30% were


