| 1 | P1/P2 request license plate be confirmed via NCIC/TCIC prior to lights/sirens | 0 | 2 | 4 |
| 2 | P1/P2 notifies dispatch of traffic stop location, license plate, description of vehicle, occupants, etc.) | 0 | 2 | 4 |
| 3 | P1/P2 request for a backup unit | 0 | 2 | 4 |
| 4 | P1 request dispatch to hold or close the radio channel on all radio traffic/communication | 0 | 2 | 4 |
| 5 | P1 uses public address (PA) system (If available) or loud voice to shout commands | 0 | 2 | 4 |
| 6 | P1 commands all occupants to put their hands up | 0 | 2 | 4 |
| 7 | P1 commands the driver to turn off the vehicle and drop the keys on the ground | 0 | 2 | 4 |
| 8 | P1 commands the driver to exit the vehicle with their hands up and stand facing away from them | 0 | 2 | 4 |
| 9 | P1 commands the driver to grab their shirt collar and pull shirt up and turn around slowly | 0 | 2 | 4 |
| 10 | P1 repeats commands as necessary to place driver in position near front bumper area of the LE vehicles | 0 | 2 | 4 |
| 11 | P2 or B3 takes over verbal commands and tells the suspect any additional commands for proper position | 0 | 2 | 4 |
| 12 | P2 or B3 approaches the driver and handcuffs in a prone or kneeling position (Double- locks handcuffs) | 0 | 2 | 4 |
| 13 | B3 walks the driver to the rear of the vehicle: questions about # of suspects, names. weapon, drugs in vehicle, etc. | 0 | 2 | 4 |
| 14 | P2 or B3 obtains identification and places subject “under arrest” for valid warrant or has PC for an offense | 0 | 2 | 4 |
| 15 | P2 or B3 completes thorough search of the driver to find all evidence (Ex. Mask, gloves, weapon, knife, monies) | 0 | 2 | 4 |
| 16 | P2 or B3 Simulate unloading and securing of weapon found on suspect | 0 | 2 | 4 |
| 17 | Arrestee is placed in back of LE vehicle, seat belted in place, vehicle door closed and locked | 0 | 2 | 4 |
| 18 | P1 repeats commands as necessary until all visible persons are removed from the suspect’s vehicle and detained | 0 | 2 | 4 |
| 19 | P1 and B4 approach the vehicle in a tactical safe style (No crossfire situations) and clear it including the trunk | 0 | 2 | 4 |
| 20 | Team member checks all subjects via NCIC/TCIC for warrant and criminal history | 0 | 2 | 4 |
| 21 | Team member checks all firearms for stolen via NCIC/TCIC providing make, model, serial #, caliber) | 0 | 2 | 4 |
