



Free & Reduced Lunch Application: Breakfast (and lunch) are not universally free for all students. If you would like your child to eat meals at school, you will either need to put money on their online account, using this link, or you will need to secure a free/reduced lunch status by filling out the required

Rising 7th Grade Vaccine Information: The state of North Carolina requires all rising 7th graders to receive meningococcal and Tdap vaccines prior to 7th grade entry. If your child has already been vaccinated, please send in a copy of the vaccine record to our school nurse. If not, please contact their pediatrician, or the Alamance County Health Department now at 336-570-6459 to schedule an appointment.
