

As a 10th grade scholar, what music courses can I register for?

If you are planning on being in a music ensemble, you should register for Concert Band, Sinfonia Orchestra, Royal Voices or Treble Choir.

Other music elective options include:

- Jazz Band alternating day, full year
- Guitar 1, Guitar 2
- Music Production Studio
- Songwriting
- Beginning Piano
- Soul Strings
- Create Your Own Ensemble (Project Based Music)

As an 11th & 12th grade scholar, what music courses can I register for?

Your music teacher can make a recommendation for you as there are multiple upper level ensembles in band, orchestra & choir. The counselors also know which courses are a good fit for your level. You may also register for the above music elective courses as they are open to anyone in high school.

Is it possible to take more than one music ensemble or class?

YES! Scholars can participate in two ensembles and also do a music elective.

What classes need to be taken with an alternating ensemble class?

Music ensemble courses are alternating day classes. Students will need to select an alternating day class to accompany their music ensembles. Sinfonia Orchestra, Concert Band, Jazz Band, Treble Choir are alternative day courses that can also be taken with another music ensemble course.
