The Glenwood band program is sending 46 events to the State Solo and Ensemble Contest. This year's contest is being held at Atlantic High School. A large portion of the concert band is involved in this event and will be performing in various groups throughout the day. I strongly encourage you to come, listen to and support the Glenwood band during their performance(s).

Please make sure that you are dressed in appropriate performance attire. This is a formal event! Gentlemen should wear shirts and ties. Ladies should wear dresses, skirts or pant suits. NO JEANS! Bring a change of clothes, pillow, blanket and anything else that you need to relax with when you are done with your performance and while you are traveling on the bus. Before getting on your assigned bus make sure that you check for working instruments, playable reeds, valve oil, slide grease, drum sticks, music and whatever else you need to get you through the performance.

While you are not performing I expect you to watch a minimum of 5 events from other schools and 10 of our 46. There will be NO horse play in the gym. Violators will be permanently placed in a center for the rest of the day.

An assortment of concession stand goodies will be available for purchase while in Atlantic so bring some money. You are also welcome to bring your own snacks and a sack lunch to get you through the day. We **will not** be going out to eat and students are not allowed to leave the school. Parents are more than welcome to bring something into the school for students to eat.

We will have an early bus leave at 12:00 with students who don't have afternoon events. The afternoon buses will leave when all of the ballots are released to the directors after the last performance of the day at approximately 5:30. You are welcome to leave with parents as soon as you have finished with all of your performances. Please be sure to take your instrument with you.
