



Junior/Senior Prom - Rules and Regulations

TQL Stadium - First Financial Club

As stated on page 21 of the [STUDENT/PARENT HANDBOOK](#), all students should recognize that academics takes precedence before any extracurricular school activity. All students wishing to attend Prom must be in attendance at school by 9:30 a.m. on the day of Prom and remain until the end of the school day in order to participate.

- Tickets for Junior/Senior Prom will cost \$30.00 per person/\$60.00 per couple and be on sale from Monday March 30th through 11:59 pm on April 13th. Ticket sale dates are firm, please plan accordingly. All sales are FINAL and no refunds will be issued. No exceptions. All sales are done online, with a credit card.
- Students who have paid for a date, but need to change their date's information, may do so online until 12 noon on Thursday, April 16th.
- There will be NO dinner with Prom this year. We will be offering soft drinks and water throughout the evening.
- Students will be REQUIRED to be in prom at TQL stadium no later than **8:30 p.m.** If a student and/or guest has a legitimate conflict that will necessitate coming to the dance after 8:30 p.m. a printed note from a parent/guardian must be turned in by 3pm on Wednesday, April 15th. Junior notes go to Ms. Caito and Senior notes go to Ms. Gilb.
- Entrance and Parking: Entrance is at TQL's First Financial Club. There is a parking garage that is next to the entrance into First Financial Club for student parking. Upon entry all cars will receive a parking ticket to enter the garage, upon leaving the driver will need that parking ticket to exit the garage and pay the \$5 parking fee. A lost ticket will incur a \$15 lost ticket fee. [Garage directions and entry directions](#)
- Students are permitted to bring one guest to Prom. Students will be required to enter their guest's name, phone number, high school name as well as their guest's guardian(s) name and contact information. This will be entered electronically at the time of the ticket purchase. Saint Ursula Academy will share guest names with administration at the corresponding high school to ensure good academic standing.

- Students are responsible for the behavior and conduct of their guests at all times. SUA students should discuss rules and regulations with guests ahead of time and clearly communicate that the guest must comply with all SUA and TQL policies. Guests who do not comply with the rules may be asked to leave and the SUA student may be subject to disciplinary measures.
- No backpacks, gym bags, or duffle bags will be permitted inside the venue. Do not attempt to bring any of these items into the venue. A small purse IS permitted, but is subject to search.
- Students will not be permitted to leave the dance before it is over at 10:30 pm. Once students and their guests leave the venue, they will NOT be able to re-enter.
- As stated on page 29 of the Student/Parent Handbook, no limousines, taxis, carriages, buses, or rideshare services may be used to transport students to and from Prom.
- We strive to make Prom an event that is memorable for our students. We take seriously the responsibility of providing a safe environment for our students and their guests. As we do for all our dances, breathalyzers will be used at Prom. Couples are randomly chosen as they enter the venue and both members are tested. If it is determined that a student or her guest has consumed alcohol, the student's parents will be notified and both the student and her guest will need to be picked up from the dance immediately. Further disciplinary action by Saint Ursula or the guest's school may be taken.
- We ask that good judgment is exercised regarding pre-dance and post-dance activities. Please refer to page 28-29 of the Student/Parent Handbook for our policy and state laws concerning alcohol and/or drug consumption. Thank you for your help in keeping this evening safe and fun.
