EOP PROMPTS FOR CSU APPLICATION

- Make sure to answer **ALL PARTS OF THE QUESTION**.
- *Don't shy away from showing hardship... Readers need to understand your life / educational context. They need to hear everything that you work through. It's not just ok, but recommended to write about difficult experiences like being on welfare, receiving food assistance or free or reduced lunch, being in foster care, being an English language learner, having a learning disability, being undocumented, poor initial high school performance with turn around, etc.*
- *We need details! If your dad is on disability (how many yrs). If family receives food assistance (for how many years), etc.*

Briefly describe your family's economic background. Include information about your financial challenges. If you qualify for free or reduced lunch, definitely answer this question. (2,500 characters max)

Why would you like to attend college? Discuss your career and personal goals. Are there any particular circumstances, school experiences, or persons that influenced your preparation or motivation to attend college (e.g., cultural/financial background, family, teachers, schools you attended)? Please explain. (2,500 characters max)

Briefly discuss your academic background. Did you utilize any additional support at your high school, such as tutoring? Do your grades in high school and/or college reflect your academic ability or potential? (2,500 characters max)

List any volunteer, extracurricular activities, or work experiences in which you are or have been involved in the past two years? (2,500 characters max)

Is there any additional information you would like EOP to consider in determining your admission to the program? Definitely

include: Any obstacles you have had to overcome? (Ex: Family circumstances? Financial difficulties? Disabilities? Additional responsibilities? Undocumented Status? Personal struggles?) **Explain (2,500 characters max)**

Examples:

- If you haven't done the best you could in high school, focus on your potential and motivation to go to college and the need for guidance and support from programs like EOP (IN YOUR OWN WORDS)
- If your GPA is 3.5 or higher, mention that you have done well in high school because you have been in a school that provides support (explain the type of support) and that you want to go to college knowing that you are a part of a program that will provide you the guidance and resources you need to do your best. (IN YOUR OWN WORDS)

If you answer YES/TRUE to these 3 questions, answer the prompt below:

1. Are you applying to a UCB, UCD, UCSB or UCSC?
2. Your parents did not graduate from a 4 year college in the U.S
3. You qualify for Free or Reduced Lunch

Why do you want to be in EOP (a program that helps students graduate!) - ONLY 240 characters (1-2 sentences) - Consider mentioning EOP supports offered that you think might help you such as mentoring, advising, tutoring, summer bridge.
