

Course Selection Guidelines:

- Course selections are entered online through the "Aeries Portal" from January 29th through February 7th.
- Log in to the "Aeries Portal." Under the "classes" tab, click "course request" and select courses by course number.
- Review the WHS Course Catalog for course descriptions and course prerequisites: WHS Course Catalog
- Review your **Transcript** under the "**Grades**" tab in the Aeries portal.
- Choose courses based on WHS graduation requirements, A-G entrance requirements, career &/or personal interest.
- Choose Core (includes: English, World History and a CTE course), Math, PE, Science, & Elective.
- Select alternate courses. WHS cannot always accommodate a student's first choice.
- Make your selections carefully as it is rarely possible to make adjustments later. Scheduling of classes depends on enrollment, facilities, and staffing.
