Other Business Items:

Ballot measures:

A ballot measure cannot be used to change the maximum taxing rate for the district.

A ballot measure can be used in 2 ways:

1 - a 5-year ballot measure to increase funding to cover general repairs/maintenance/operational costs

2 - a 10-year ballot measure to go towards capital improvements of the district
The process for pursuing a ballot measure is long and arduous - we'd need to put out an email supporting what the cost have been verses the income to show that the income has not kept up with the cost of maintenance in the past years.

9. Private Committees: Judith McKee reported they are waiting on bids from paving companies for the paving project on Green Ridge Loop.

10. Road Maintenance: The overlay on the entrance may be done in May 2026, weather permitting. The Seal coating will follow the paving.

Future Projects: The Board agrees that instead of grading the roads that it will be more advantageous to bring rock in to keep the roads from continued deterioration.
