- Deep insights into the systems you are operating in and seek to affect;
- A systemic design to the initiative you want to work on;
- A systemic theory of change;
- A monitoring, evaluation and learning plan;
- 10 hours of pro bono consulting per month.

## **Eligibility:**

Applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Must be a team of minimum 2 people;
- You must be very early in your operations;
- You must be a non-profit or social enterprise or in the process of getting established as one;
- Your budget is less than 500,000 dollars;
- You have or are in the process of forming an advisory board;
- You are or seek to work on a transformative social or environmental change issue.
  We are especially interested in supporting initiatives related to the following:
  - o Social change,
  - o Regeneration,
  - o Climate,
  - o Racial equity,
  - o Indigenous rights.
