

The Barrington High School Computer Club just competed in the Second Contest in the American Computer Science League.

Each student was given several questions based on computer concepts and asked to solve a programming problem. Individually students earn up to five points in both the question and programming parts of the contest.

Team scores are based on the top three individual student scores in each Division/Team. With 30 points being the maximum Team score possible.

The Barrington High School Computer Club team competes in two different divisions: Senior and Intermediate.

The Senior Division team earned a perfect score of 30 points. The Intermediate Team 1 earned 29 points. Intermediate Team 2 earned 9 points

Top scores were:
