1. The Catastrophe

On June 24th, the north-central region of Venezuela was hit by two consecutive slip-strike earthquakes just 38 seconds apart from one another, a rare but devastating event. Featuring consecutive major earthquakes measuring 7.2 and 7.5 on the Richter scale.

Multiple states were affected, **Falcon, Miranda, Carabobo, Aragua** and **Anzoategui** reported infrastructure damages with the epicenter taking place in the **Yaracuy** state, causing critical impacts across multiple central states of the country.

In the capital, **Caracas**, sectors such as Altamira, Los Palos Grandes and San Bernardino suffered severe structural collapses and compromises. The most affected state was **La Guaira** (formerly called Vargas).



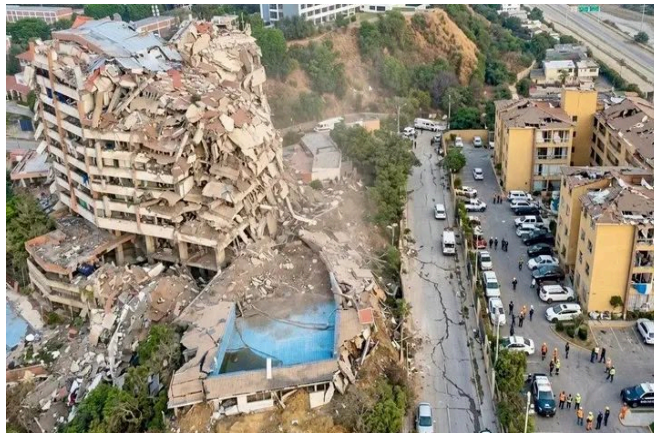
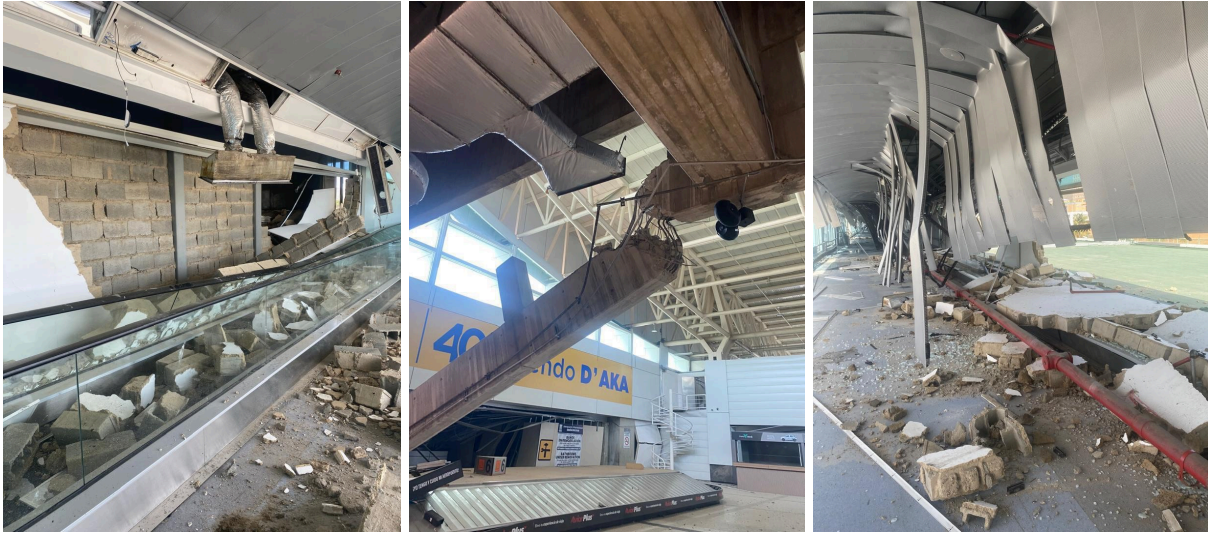
The Critical Situation in La Guaira (Ground Zero)

The state of La Guaira is formally a natural disaster area due to a unique set of geographical and geological characteristics that **severely** amplified the impact of the disaster. A lot of La Guaira's critical infrastructure and residential zones were built on soft sediments and alluvial soils.

These soft ground layers act as natural amplifiers for seismic energy, subjecting buildings and structures to forces they were never built to withstand. An overwhelming majority of the total collapses occurred directly in La Guaira's coastline, decimating entire residential areas and high density sectors like Caraballeda and Catia La Mar

La Guaira being damaged so severely is particularly devastating for the country's economy, as it's the main port city of the country, and is also where the country's main international airport is located (The **Maiquetía "Simón Bolívar" International Airport**). Both ports and said airports have suffered severe damage and are currently not

operational.



The staff behind this charity effort personally know multiple people that have completely lost their homes due to this tragedy, and some of us even have had our own homes partially affected too.

The loss of life is estimated to surpass **10.000 fatalities** by the US Geological Service (USGS), with more than **50.000 people officially missing** to this day (July 1st). Material damage costs are estimated to be around **8.7 billion USD**, with 58.000 buildings expected to have been partially or completely compromised by the sequential shockwaves that to this day, still occur in the affected areas.

Furthermore, critical failures in potable water, electricity and telecommunication networks continue to heavily complicate immediate international rescue and humanitarian assistance efforts.



Earthquake Shaking  Red Alert

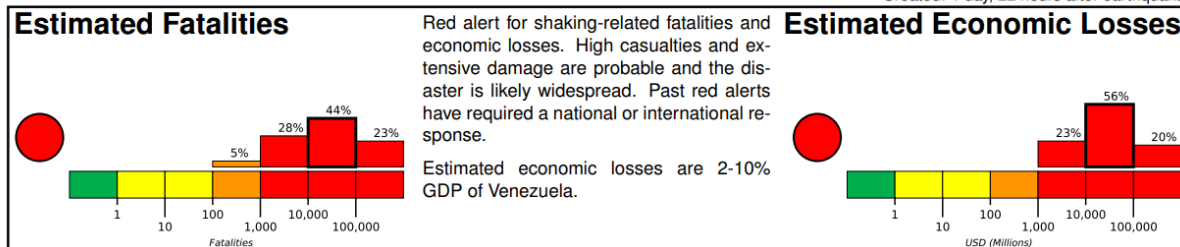

The magnitude of this tragedy is something the country was severely unprepared for, and **a lot** of the labor has fallen onto everyday citizens and volunteer work. The sheer scale of this disaster has completely overwhelmed the response capabilities of local public institutions and official emergency services. In catastrophes of this magnitude, the initial 72 hours and the subsequent weeks are critical to saving lives and preventing epidemiological outbreaks.

Civil society intervention and third-party support are **absolutely vital** not only for immediate response but also for **Medium and Long-Term Sustenance**. **More than 15,000 individuals** have lost their homes permanently.

Continuous funding through certified charities is **the only mechanism** that guarantees these families receive three meals a day, blankets, clean water and psychological care during a reconstruction process that will take years.

3. **Save your receipt**, a clear screenshot or picture of the transaction.
4. **Share your receipt** with the organizing team through an admin's Discord DMs to validate your entry ([@whatsappdanger](#) / [@cemichu](#)).
5. After validating your entry, our team will **DM** you the code required for the registration on the **Limitless** platform.

- **Local Charities:** Reliable and efficient relief funds based in Venezuela, operating actively in the country. They operate directly on the ground, meaning your financial aid bypasses bureaucratic hurdles to provide food, medical tools and shelter management straight to the victims.
- **International Charities:** Organizations with extensive disaster aid experience and reliable, robust reputation. They also hold flexible, global payment systems and methods.

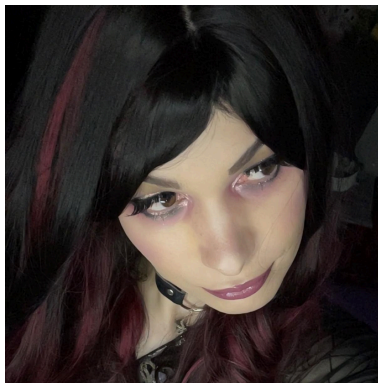
