
Edit Photos with Google Photos

- 1. Open a browser on your laptop and go to photos.google.com.
- Locate the image you would like to edit. Click on it to open.
- 3. Click on the pencil icon to bring up the edit tools.



4. These editing tools will allow you to make changes to the image.





a. Color Filters:

- These will allow you to set the tone of the image.
- Basic Adjustments:
 - i. This allows you to adjust the light, color, and pop of your image.
 - ii. There are also sub settings within those 3 above.
- c. Crop and Rotate:
 - i. This allows you to rotate and crop your image

5. Once you are done editing you can either save the image (overwrites the original one) or "Save a Copy" which will create a new image while retaining the original.
