As we continue to work on routines we will be focusing on quiet hallways and safe walking lines. These may seem like little things, but they matter at school in a community of many learners. Our day still feels long for many of our kindergarten friends, but we are persevering. I look forward to a great week!



Math focuses on the writing of numbers 6-8 and the one to one correspondence that goes along with knowing our numbers. Phonics has us learning /t/ and /p/ and reading our "heart words": "said", "the", and "I". Reading has us discussing why and how people take care of their pets. Writing is focusing on letter formation and correct pencil grip. Social Studies continues to focus on classroom citizenship with us exploring empathy. ChristLight shows us God's almighty power and mercy as he saved Noah's family from the flood and when he separates and spreads out his people at the Tower of Babel.

What we are learning in 4th Grade:

Christ Light: The Tower of Babel and Abraham's Trust in God will be our focus this week. We will also review the story of the Flood.

Reading: We will be looking at a selection entitled <u>My Librarian is a Camel.</u> We will focus on cause and effect and how an author uses that to help the reader understand the information being presented. We will also talk about how to visualize the characters as we read.

Grammar: In grammar we will be talking about how to use quotation marks in writing.

Writing: We will continue our study on writing a good paragraph. Students will be taught how to use a T-chart to help them organize their thoughts before writing a paragraph.

Subject Work This Week

- → **Bible History:** It did not take mankind long to demonstrate that he had lost the image of God in which he was created. In love, God sent the flood so that his promise to send the Savior would not die out.
- → **Doctrine:** We are studying the basics of the Bible. God's Word was written that we may believe Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and by believing we might have life in his name. There will be a summary review on Tuesday. We will begin the First Commandment on Thursday.
- → **Memory Work:** Monday Passages 7-8; Wednesday Passages 9-10; next Monday Passages 11=12
- → 5-6 History/Geography: We are studying cardinal and intermediate directions. The African country maps are due on Friday. Africa timelines are due Friday, September 19. We will complete our world history study of India and begin a study of China.
- → **7-8 History:** The colonies in North America were established by European countries that hoped to make money from America. The real value of the colonies, however, was their independent, hardworking people who risked everything, hoping to build a better life for themselves far from home. Test on Tuesday. Students need to study for the test
- → **Literature:** Reading Skills, study guide page 1- quiz Wednesday. We are reading the novel *Where the Red Fern Grows*. The students have a guide packet to fill out with each chapter. The students will be able to use their notes for quizzes on the novel. The first quiz is on Chapters 1-4 is Tuesday.

Bible History/Hymnology: We will continue singing "By Faith" by Keith and Kristyn Getty. We will also work on "Reformation Song" that the students will be able to sing and share on 10/5 at Bethany and again on 10/12 at Abiding Shepherd.

7th Grade Literature: We will be reviewing genres and making connections. We also will be starting to study plots, characters, and settings.

8th Grade Notes

- -This week in religion class we are studying the roller coaster of faith that Abraham takes in Genesis 15-19. There are some rough consequences for bad choices in this section, so we will talk about how our faith gets us through those times in our life.
- -Things are getting interesting in *A Midsummer Night's Dream*, as the plans of the characters are not going the way they thought they would. When plans fail, is anyone in control? 
