UHS Book Club Picks

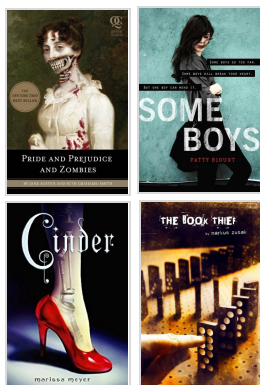
