The Regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing, together with the rules of the participating classes and any additional sailing instructions to be issued at the competitors' meeting.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 Sailing Instructions will be posted at https://www.westriversc.com/juniorregatta no later than June 25th, 2025.

ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to 29er, Club 420, ILCA 6/Laser Radial, Optimist, W/B/R & Green.
- 3.2 Age: Sailors may only compete if (a) they will not be older than nineteen (19) years of age at any time during 2025 (*i.e.*, their twentieth (20th) birthday occurs no earlier than January 1, 2025) AND (b) they have not competed in any collegiate sailing event prior to the regatta.
- 3.3 Compensation: As this is an amateur regatta held in the Corinthian spirit of competition, sailors may not compete as skipper or crew if they are or will be paid or otherwise compensated for participating in the regatta. By registering for the regatta, each sailor affirms that neither he/she nor his/her crew is being paid or otherwise compensated for competing.
- 3.4 Optimist sailors shall not reach their 16th birthday in 2025.
- 3.5 Pinnies are recommended but not required.

By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other

boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.
