The Colorado Early Childhood Comprehensive Systems: Health Integration Prenatal-to-Three Project (CO-ECCS)
works to advance the infrastructure, capacity, equity, and sustainability of Colorado's maternal and early childhood

systems of care and will be implemented collaboratively by key agencies comprising Colorado's infrastructure for the delivery and coordination of prenatal-to-three (P-3) services.

The **CO-ECCS Project** understands that *in Colorado, pregnant people and families with young children face barriers to access support and often struggle to receive the services they want or need, with some families facing even greater challenges than others because of systemic racism, classism, and other inequities.*

The CO-ECCS Project supports Colorado in achieving its vision that:

"All children are valued, healthy, and thriving and have equal access to services, supports and resources."

The ECCS Working Group is charged as an advisory group to the CO-ECCS Project. The Working Group will engage stakeholders in the system of wrap-around support for families during pregnancy through the first three years of a child's life to ensure alignment of Colorado's early childhood and maternal child health systems. In order to advance health equity of P-3 services, the Working Group will collect information and examine data from diverse partners to inform a P-3 Early Childhood Equity Action Plan.

Coordinated Intake and Referral System Increase the engagement of new stakeholders, such as families and health providers, in the system of wrap-around support for families during pregnancy through the first three years of a child's life.	Goal 2 Health Care and Early Childhood Partnerships Align the maternal and early childhood system to advance the sustainability of multigenerational preventive services and systems.	Goal 3 Early Childhood Equity Planning Advance health equity by engaging the Colorado Partnership for Thriving Families, Office of Maternal and Child Health, Office of Health Equity, Department of Early Childhood, and Early Childhood Leadership Commission and produce a P-3 Early Childhood Equity Action Plan.
