- '24-'25 Year End Budget - Started with \$17k budget carry over from last year, \$77.6k raised, \$81.8k expenses, \$4.2k net, \$12.8k remaining from prior year budget.
- '25-'26 Budget. Approved at September 24, 2025 General Meeting- Started with \$20k; still need expenses for Trunk or Treat and Book Fair; pretzel sales \$12,590 + \$1,600 as of Monday 11/3. So far, net of \$22,000 but not all expenses have been submitted.
