Abstract is the essence of the article content that consists of the research background, objective, methods, result, and conclusion with a maximum length of 250 words. Abstract should stand alone, which means that no citation, abbreviation, equation format and figures in the abstract. The abstract should be written both in English and Bahasa Indonesia for the article written in Bahasa Indonesia and the article written in English is not required to write the abstract in Bahasa Indonesia. The abstract and keywords are written by the single-spacing, italic and using font type Times New Roman 11 pts.

Keywords: Keywords should represent the content and highlight of the article (3 - 5 keywords) in alphabetical order.

INTRODUCTION (Times New Roman 11, Bold, Uppercase, space 1.5)

The introduction contains the purpose of the article/research formulated and presented with adequate background. The introduction should include the **urgency of the study**, **supporting facts from previous studies, gap analysis, research status, the novelty, and research objectives**. Gap analysis means the gap found in previous studies, while the status of the study is the position of previous research whether it is correcting, debating, or supporting. References must be taken from various reputable national and international scientific journals (**indexed by SCOPUS, Web of Science, or SINTA**) that are published no more than ten years from the submission of the article. Article length is 3,500 - 6,000 words, including all images, tables, references, etc. (Times New Roman 12, space 1.5)

METHODS (Times New Roman 11, Bold, Uppercase, space 1.5)

Basically, this section explains how the research was carried out, which includes research designs, populations, and samples (research targets), data collection techniques, and



data analysis techniques. For qualitative research such as case studies, it is necessary to add research subjects, informants who helped along with ways to explore research data, location, and duration of research as well as a description of checking the validity and reliability. The method used must be accompanied by a reference from experts. The author is allowed to explain how the method was used to achieve the research objectives. The stages of the research must be clearly stated. The research method must be written in paragraph form. (Times New Roman 12, space 1.5)

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION (Times New Roman 11, Bold, Uppercase, space 1.5)

The results and discussion must be clear and concise. Results and discussions contain elaboration of scientific research findings and not just display detailed data. In this section, it is hoped that the author can focus on the differences in the findings in the research conducted by the author and previous studies that have been published. Therefore, avoid citing extensively in the results and discussion sections.

The discussion section is the most important part of the author's article. Through data analysis and discussion, the author must be able to make the article attractive to the target group of readers. The following components should be part of the results and discussion: (1) how the author's research results relate to the research objectives and questions stated in the introduction. What are the findings of the study? (what/how); (2) Has the author made a scientific interpretation of each research result presented in the manuscript? This interpretation must be supported by a valid analysis (why); (3) Are the authors' results consistent with previous studies? Or is there a difference? (what else) (Times New Roman 12, space 1.5)

Tables and Images

Presentation using tables can help explaining discussions more accurately and attractively. Thus, the presentation can also be shortened. Tables and figures should be numbered continuously following the presentation order (Table 1, Table 2, and so forth) and should be cited on referred texts. Title of table should be as complete as possible and should be positioned above the table.



The conclusion must refer to the research objectives and contain general conclusions from the research results, not repeat the abstract, in the form of paragraphs, not points. Provide a clear scientific justification for your work and indicate possible applications and extensions. (Times New Roman 12, space 1.5)

REFERENCES (Times New Roman 11, Bold, Uppercase, space 1.5)

Write down all references cited and actually written in the text from primary sources (80% taken from reputable scientific journals) and use the most recent references (last 10 years). The minimum number of references is **20 references**. Writing a bibliography/reference using APA (*American Psychological Association*) 6th edition using Reference Manager Applications such as **Mendeley, Endnote,** or **Zotero**.
