- Utilize manufacturing procedures to build subassemblies from components, apply software, and conduct final testing.
- Update manufacturing process documentation to standardize the information across product lines, improve clarity and optimize the process.
- Identify improvements for manufacturing fixturing. Update the corresponding documents and drawings as well as performing the necessary qualification actions.
