## What Type of Visa Is Required for India?

Tourists who are in India for less than 72 hours may apply for a Transit Visa. However, an affirmed aircraft reservation must be presented while applying. Generally, a Tourist visa to India is required.

Your nationality will determine the length of your Tourist visa.

Tourist visas for up to 10 years are available for Japan, Canada, and the United States. Additionally, five-year Tourist visas of up to 10 years validity are becoming more accessible to individuals from all countries that have biometric enlistment office access. Another thing is that Tourist visas are generally issued for three to a year or one year. Visas can be issued for different sections <u>India Urgent Visa</u>.



It is important to know that visas are valid from the date they were issued, not the date they were obtained upon landing in India.

You are not permitted to stay in India longer than a year (180 days), regardless of how substantial your visa is.

Some Tourist visas allow for stays of up to three months. Also, despite the fact that there was a multi-month gap between Indian Tourist visa visits, it has been reopened for citizens of all other countries.

There are many types of visas available for Indian guests, including Intern visas and Employment visas.

## **Indian Tourist Visa Cost:**

As per the game plan between countries, the cost of an Indian Tourist Visa varies between countries. Current rates effective July 1, 2018, are compelling. For five to ten years, the cost for US citizens is \$160. This is a remarkable price considering that a 60-day E visa costs \$100. Handling costs \$19.90 and is an additional cost. Other accidental costs may also be involved, such as a Biometric Enrollment fee, which is not a large amount.

Some countries, such as Japan and Mongolia, have extraordinary agreements with India that allow their citizens to pay significantly less for visas. The visa fee is not required for natives of Afghanistan (Argentina, Bangladesh, Democratic People's Republic of Korea), Jamaica, Maldives Mauritius, Mongolia and Seychelles (for as long as three months), South Africa, Uruguay, and Uruguay.

Where and How to Apply for an Indian Visa

Private handling organizations are allowed to use the Indian visa application process. Your application should be presented to the relevant organization in your country, not to the Indian Embassy and Consulate.
