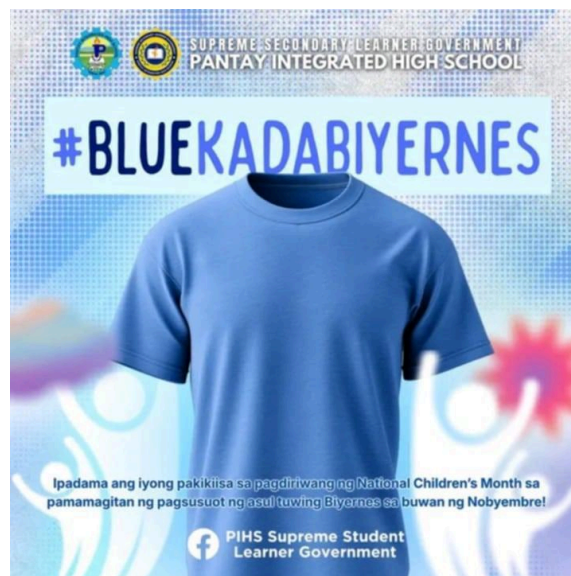
Moreover, the initiative demonstrated the school's continuing commitment to uphold children's rights and ensure that learners feel safe, respected, supported, and valued in their educational journey.


