SECTION 4 | HOW THIS SERVICE WORKS

How Portfolio Debris Hauling Works in Modesto

portfolio debris hauling in Modesto follows a coordinated process across managed sites. The steps below describe how a recurring program is set up and run for a portfolio or managed building.

Step 1: Portfolio Review and Program Setup

The first step is a review of the managed properties to understand the clearance needs at each site, the expected debris types and volumes, and the scheduling that suits the portfolio. A recurring program is set up with the manager so each property is covered on a cadence that matches its needs.

Step 2: Scheduling Across Sites

Haul-offs are scheduled across the managed properties so clearance happens on a predictable cadence. The schedule is coordinated with building and association management and tenant activity, so removals fit around the operation of each managed property rather than being arranged individually each time debris accumulates.

Step 3: Clearance and Sorting at Each Site

At each scheduled visit, crews clear the debris from the property, sorting recyclable cardboard, metal, and material from general waste during loading. Common areas, multi-tenant buildings, and portfolio sites are cleared to the same standard so every managed property is kept consistently clear across the program.

Loaded material is transported to facilities permitted to accept each type, with recyclable streams separated. Central Modesto
