Child Safety Week 2025 is here!

Like every year, we invite you to join Arpan's 'Child Safety Week' campaign to raise awareness, amplify conversations and encourage collective action to prevent Child Sexual Abuse (CSA) and heal those affected by it. In 2024, Arpan's campaign #ProtectedByPOCSO marked a turning point — it was the first time the campaign directly addressed offenders, delivering a stark message: "Child Sexual Abuse is a punishable offence – Stop Right Now or Get Caught."

The 7th edition of **Child Safety Week 2025** builds on that momentum with a sharper focus on deterrence and enforcement. This year's theme, "**POCSO Pakad Lega**," delivers an uncompromising message to every offender: *If you sexually abuse a child, the law will catch you*.

18 November: World Day for the Prevention of and Healing from Child Sexual Exploitation, Abuse, and Violence



Did you know? In 2023 alone, nearly 9 million reports of Child Se*ual Abuse Material (CSAM) came from India, making our country one of the highest in the world.

CSAM is created when someone makes, shares, or circulates inappropriate videos or images of children. And it's a punishable offence under the Protection of Children from Se*ual Offences (POCSO) Act.

But this can be stopped. Children can be protected, and those who've faced abuse can heal — if each of us acts.

This World Day for the Prevention of and Healing from Child Exploitation, Abuse, and Violence, take a pledge to play your part.

If you ever see someone making, sharing, or forwarding such videos, don't stay silent, warn them
