**Course Syllabus: English for Master's Studies 1**

**Course Description**

This course is designed for English language learners seeking to develop foundational academic reading and writing skills. Using real-world themes from various disciplines, students will build confidence in reading comprehension, vocabulary, grammar, and paragraph writing. Students will learn to identify main ideas and supporting details, understand vocabulary in context, and skim or scan for information. Writing instruction focuses on developing clear and organized paragraphs, including descriptive, opinion, explanatory, and process-based writing. Grammar topics and sentence variety are taught in context to support writing accuracy. Each unit integrates various skills with critical thinking strategies, such as organizing ideas and making predictions.

**Course Objectives**

By the end of the course, students will be able to

- Plan, draft, and revise structured paragraphs across different academic topics.
- Apply reading strategies to extract key information from academic texts.
- Use a range of sentence structures and grammatical forms to improve writing clarity.
- Apply critical thinking to tasks related to academic content.
