

(Link embeds are being funky, so if they don't work, just copy and paste the bolded addresses next to them.)

- The interactive PDF has 3 text boxes with guidelines where you can insert your own text. You can do this with various programs, or with websites that allow you to fill in text on PDFs ([like this site](https://www.docfly.com/pdf-form-filler) - **<https://www.docfly.com/pdf-form-filler>**)
- You can also do this manually on the flat PNG, or by opening the inDesign file on the webpage.
- I downloaded the actual font file (Skilt Gothic Regular) from the internet for free ([here](https://www.onlinewebfonts.com/download/b38970a1d0962ca826f87d54aa5f1e37) - **<https://www.onlinewebfonts.com/download/b38970a1d0962ca826f87d54aa5f1e37>**) and installed it onto my computer. You can do this, or just experiment and see if you can find a similar font.
 - All 3 text fields are in the font "Skilt Gothic Regular" and are size 11.5. The color I used is hex code **#454d29** or RGB **R=69 G=77 B=41**.
