DIRECTIONS AND USES

- **Sweet & Juicy Soaps:** One of the most popular uses for Tangerine Essential Oil is soapmaking, where it adds a fresh, fruity scent. Add Tangerine Essential Oil at 0.5–2% in your soap blend. Test a small batch to find your ideal fragrance strength. Due to phototoxic properties, these soaps are best used in the evening or on days with low sun exposure.
- **Tangerine Twist Candles:** Use 0.5–1% of Tangerine Essential Oil for a lively, juicy aroma. Start with a trial batch to perfect your scent throw before moving to larger production.
- **Citrus Kiss Creams:** Use up to 0.5% of Tangerine Essential Oil in your creams to brighten skin care with a sweet, tangy aroma. Start with a small trial batch and remind users to patch test and limit sun exposure after use.
- **Zesty Body Oils & Scrubs:** Add 0.5% or less of Tangerine Essential Oil to create a fresh, energizing scent that awakens the senses. As with all citrus oils, patch test before use and avoid direct sunlight after application due to phototoxicity.
- **Vacation Breeze Aromatherapy:** Use Tangerine Essential Oil in diffusers at 3–5 drops per 100 ml water to fill any space with a juicy citrus scent that refreshes the mood.
- **Sweet Signature Scents:** Add up to 1% of Tangerine Essential Oil in your fragrance blends to create playful, bright perfumes. It mixes beautifully with floral, woody, and spicy notes like lavender, cedarwood, and cinnamon for a well-rounded scent.
- **A Fresh & Clean Home:** Incorporate 0.5% or less of Tangerine Essential Oil into cleaning sprays or room fresheners for a natural, invigorating citrus aroma.
