Abstract: The abstract should summarize the contents of the paper and should contain at least 70 and at most 200 words (exclude the keywords). It should be set in 9-point font size, justified and should have a hanging indent of 2-centimeter.

Keywords: We recommend the paper to have at least three to five keywords. The text should be set in 9-point font size and without the use of bold or italic font style. Please use a comma as a separator. Keywords must be title cased.

1 INTRODUCTION

The requirements for writing manuscripts in the 4th ICPE 2025 refer to the Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association, Sixth Edition, therefore we ask that authors follow the guidelines explained in this example in order to achieve the highest quality possible. Manuscript should be written in Times New Roman font, 10-pt, and in English with proper grammar and vocabulary. Be advised that papers in a technically unsuitable form will be returned for retyping.

This section consists of two paragraphs. The first paragraph contains a study of literature related to the contents of the manuscript, explaining what has been researched and reported by others by referring to journals (Jonker et al., 2020), proceedings, books, chapters of books with multiple authors, websites, newspapers, and others. The second paragraph briefly describes the framework or outline of the manuscript, for example that related to the literature study, observations which have been made with other ranges of parameters with a modified model. The method of observation will be explained in the materials and methods section and the results of the research are written in the results and discussion.

2 MATERIALS AND METHODS

This section can also entitle Models or Experiments. It is also possible for a manuscript to have both Theory and Experiment sections at the same time if necessary.

This section can also contain quotes from literature that are considered important to be compared or used in the results and discussion sections, if they cannot be expressed in other forms (e.g., equations, figures, tables).

A manuscript may consist of an Introduction, Theory (and/or Experiment, and/or Model, and/or method), Results and discussion sections, and Conclusions. This is followed by the Acknowledgments (if any) and Reference sections. Each subsection should have different contents.

3 RESULTS

This section contains the results obtained using the methods described in the previous section (i.e., Theory or Experiments and/or Models). This section can contain tables and figures.

For tables, authors are welcome to make them neatly in Microsoft Excel so you can copy them right away and format them like Table 1.

The maximum table width is 7 cm and the height is 20 pages and cannot be separated by page break.

Write down your conclusions in this section. Briefly and concisely. Do not repeat too much in the Results and Discussion sections, but summarize. This section is just one paragraph.
