**Opening Prayer/Reflection** – Father Jeff Jackson. Two collections were selected and read from the Book of Common Prayer centering on social justice and social service.

**Life Cycle of Organizations** - Father Jeff led a session for revisiting the life cycles of our church and continuing our attentive and collective discussion. The "cycles" include the birth formation: All the things that make us who we are, i.e., the basics and practices that sustain the congregation - prayers, services, etc.; traits of a healthy parish; watchful oversight to ensure we do not become stagnant or stale; and the ongoing quest for renewal of our purpose and identity.

The Vestry discussed our strengths as a parish community which include a healthy and stable congregational status and one that is attracting new visitors/parishioners. It was noted that our church community is enjoying visiting between and after services and being together.

• **Budget reminders -** Stewardship committee held its last meeting in September 2025. We need to get the budget together for inclusion in the stewardship packet - including leadership and employer compensation.

Food need - Work with other community partners and optimize our parish efforts and impact.

**Pumpkin Fest Debrief -** Committee debrief on Tuesday, Nov 4. A great event and discussion to improve ensued.

**Recycling Provider -** City of Carrollton used to pick up. Pauline manages recycling and takes it to the convenience center. Paper and cardboard are now the items. Petal Recycling is \$48/month to pick up in a gray bin. \$576 annually. They also sort for us. Work into the budget for 2026 and encourage parishioners to give a little more to cover? **MOTION by Georgia. Second by Michael. Approved by all.**
